Dear Ronald:



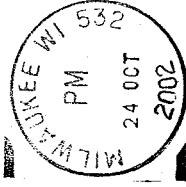
