**Regarding:** Your Class B Tavern and Public Entertainment Premises License Renewal Applications as agent for "Terra Restaurant Bar Inc" for "Terra Restaurant & Bar " at 600 S 6TH St.

There is a possibility that your application may be denied for one or more of the following reasons: The recommendation of the committee regarding the application shall be based on evidence presented at the hearing. Per [MCS 85-4-4](#), unless otherwise specified in the code, probative evidence concerning non-renewal, suspension or revocation may include evidence of the following: failure of the applicant to meet municipal qualifications, pending charges against or the conviction of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the circumstances of the particular licensed or permitted activity, by the applicant or by any employee or other agent of the applicant. If the activities of the applicant involve a licensed premises, whether the premises tends to facilitate a public or private nuisance or has been the source of congregations of persons which have resulted in any of the following: disturbance of the peace; illegal drug activity; public drunkenness; drinking in public; harassment of passers-by; gambling; prostitution; sale of stolen goods; public urination; theft; assaults; battery; acts of vandalism including graffiti, excessive littering, loitering, illegal parking, loud noise at times when the licensed premise is open for business; traffic violations; curfew violations; lewd conduct; display of materials harmful to minors, pursuant to s. 106-9.6; or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety and welfare, or failure to comply with the approved plan of operation. This report is written by Police Officer David NOVAK, assigned to the License Investigation Unit, Days.

The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:

1. On 07/18/2014 at 11:35am Officers were dispatched to Terra Restaurant and Bar at 600 S. 6<sup>th</sup> St for a subject down complaint. The investigation revealed that three subjects came into the bar at about 3:00am and were in the bar all night drinking alcohol with Juan CONTRERAS (husband of applicant). At about 11:20am two of the subjects got into a fight and the female was knocked unconscious. The video surveillance system was checked and showed the subjects in the bars for several hours drinking. It also showed the victim hit the suspect who then punched the victim knocking her out for 3 minutes. CONTRERAS was seen tugging on the victim while she was unconscious but did not render her aid. The two subjects were arrested for the fight, Juan CONTRARAS was arrested for Duty to Aid Victim. The applicant was cited for Class B Licensee's Responsibility.

This report is being submitted by Police Officer Michael W. ANDERSON, assigned to District Two, Day Shift.

On Friday, July 18, 2014, at 11:35 a.m., Squad 2141, Police Officer Michael W. ANDERSON, was dispatched to a Subject Down Complaint at 600 S. 6th St. (Terra Restaurant and Barr, a Class B Tavern), which was later determined to be a Battery.

The caller reported that they were a delivery driver, and they were just at the location, and there was a female unconscious inside the location.

Upon arrival, I observed that actor later identified, as Juan G. CONTRERAS (W/M 06-16-72) inside the tavern sweeping up broken glass. I entered the tavern and asked CONTRERAS what was happening, and he stated that he didn't know. I then asked him how the glass got broken, and he stated that he did not know. I then told him I was sent there because there was a report that there was an unconscious female in the tavern, and he replied that they were in the back. CONTRERAS had a very strong odor of alcoholic beverage, red glassy eyes, slow slurred speech, and appeared to be intoxicated.

I, P.O. ANDERSON, then observed that actor later identified, as Jessica P. RODRIGUEZ (W/F 08-21-95) walk through the doorway from the bar area holding the left side of her face. RODRIGUEZ was followed by the actor later identified, as Juan J. NAJERA (W/M 03-17-93), who was speaking to RODRIGUEZ in Spanish. Milwaukee Fire Department Engine 33 responded to the scene, and everyone stated that they were fine and did not need medical attention. Both RODRIGUEZ and NAJERA had a very strong odor of alcoholic beverage, red glassy eyes, slow slurred speech, and appeared to be intoxicated.

I then spoke to NAJERA and asked him what was going on to which he replied that he and RODRIGUEZ had just arrived from Texas at around 6:30 a.m., and they were at the location to see his aunt and uncle (CONTRERAS and his wife identified, as Jenny (NMN) CONTRERAS (W/F 04-09-78). NAJERA stated that they were drinking and hanging out. NAJERA stated that nothing else was going on, and there was no disturbance. NAJERA stated that RODRIGUEZ was sleeping and that who the man may have seen on the floor. NAJERA stated that he did not know why there was broken glass on the floor, and why RODRIGUEZ was holding her face.

I then spoke to RODRIGUEZ, who stated that they arrived at the tavern at 3:00 a.m. and were just hanging out. RODRIGUEZ, who is 18, admitted that she and the others were drinking alcoholic beverage. RODRIGUEZ stated that there was not disturbance, she was not injured, nor did she know why there was broken glass on the floor.

Jenny CONTRERAS arrived on scene and allowed officers access to the location surveillance system. Police Officer Matthew NOGALSKI reviewed the system while I again spoke to CONTRERAS. I informed CONTRERAS that we were reviewing the surveillance system and would know what had happened shortly. CONTRERAS then stated that he was sleeping on the bar and was waked up by a disturbance between RODRIGUEZ and NAJERA. CONTRERAS stated that next then he knew the Police and Fire Department where there.

A review of the surveillance video showed that RODRIGUEZ and NAJERA arrived at the location with and unknown male and were met by CONTRERAS. They were all observed walking around the bar for several hours talking, drinking, and arguing. Beverages were being obtained from behind the bar of the licensed premise. After a dispute, RODRIGUEZ sits in the front area by herself, then gets up and pick up a glass, which she then drops on the floor. RODRIGUEZ then stumbles picking up the glass, which she then threw at the front door. RODRIGUEZ then walks around some more. At about 11:20 a.m., NAJERA is sitting by the front door when RODRIGUEZ confronts him. RODRIGUEZ then hits NAJERA in the face. NAJERA then stands up and

punches RODRIGUEZ on the left side of her face with a right fist. RODRIGUEZ goes unconscious, drops to the floor, and lies there till regaining consciousness 3 minutes later. While RODRIGUEZ is unconscious, CONTRERAS walks to the front, picks up RODRIGUEZ'S left arm and tugs at her as he is talking to NAJERA. The delivery driver is then seen at the front door. CONTRERAS talks to the delivery driver who then leaves.

During the investigation, I, P.O. ANDERSON, also spoke to Michael J. SHEELY (W/M 06-16-71), who stated that he works for Sheely Service Inc. SHEELY stated that he arrived at the tavern to service the CO2 tanks. SHEELY stated that he tried the side door, which was locked. SHEELY then stated that he went to the front door and observed a female (RODRIGEUZ) lying on the ground unconscious, surrounded by broken glass and ice. SHEELY stated that there was a male sitting in a chair (NAJERA), and he was met at the door by a man in a suit (CONTRERAS). SHEELY stated that CONTRERAS was acting funny. SHEELY stated that he explained who he was and why he was there. SHEELY stated that he asked if the girl on the floor was ok to which CONTRERAS replied that she was drunk. SHEELY stated that CONTRERAS get trying to get him to go away telling him to come back later. SHEELY stated that he was uncomfortable with the situation and worried for the female fearing she may be in danger, so Police and Fire were called.

NAJERA was then placed into custody for causing substantial bodily harm to RODRIGUEZ by an act done with intent to cause bodily harm by punching RODRIGUEZ causing RODRIGEUZ to lose consciousness for several minutes.

CONTRERAS was then placed into custody for knowing that a crime is being committed and that RODRIGUEZ was exposed to bodily harm, and he failed to summon Law Enforcement Officers, other assistance, or providing assistance to the victim. CONTRERAS knew that compliance would not place him in danger, interfere with the duties of another, that assistance had not already been summoned, and that the crime had not been reported to law enforcement.

RODRIGUEZ, while in a in a public or private place, engaged in violent conduct by punching NAJERA in the face, circumstances in which the conduct provoked a disturbance.

4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)
6. You may then provide testimony.
  - a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
  - b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
  - c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
  - d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.

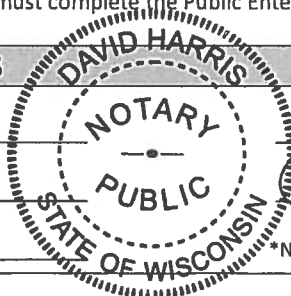




