Subject: Common Council Resolution File Number 060005

Dear Honorable Members:

Returned herewith is Common Council Resolution File Number 060005, being a petition from North Avenue Community Development Corporation to install and maintain six trash receptacles and two moveable planters in the public right-of-way adjacent to various properties along West North Avenue.

North Avenue Community Development Corporation is requesting permission to install trash receptacles and moveable planters along West North Avenue in an effort to improve the corridor between North 33 Street and North 39<sup>th</sup> Street. The six, 2-foot diameter trash receptacles will be located adjacent to locations where there is a prevalence of litter. Four trash receptacles will be located within the south, 8-foot sidewalk area of West North Avenue; one will be located within the east, 8-foot sidewalk area of North 35<sup>th</sup> Street, north of West North Avenue; and one will be located in the east, 15-foot wide sidewalk area of North 36<sup>th</sup> Street, south of West North Avenue. Both planters will be located in the south, 8-foot wide sidewalk area of West North Avenue, adjacent to the building housing the North Avenue Community Development Corporation, 3301-41 West North Avenue.

We are not aware that the presence of the aforementioned items will have an adverse effect on the general use of the public right-of-way. We have, therefore, prepared the attached special privilege resolution, which, if adopted, will allow said items to occupy the public right-of-way.
