File # 071705 is a substitute resolution relating to the application, acceptance, and funding of a Federal Emergency Agency (FEMA) grant and the State of Wisconsin Division of Emergency Management grant for costs associated with emergency snow removal and other protective measures by the City of Milwaukee.

Background

- On March 20, 2008, Governor Jim Doyle announced that federal disaster funds had been made available for local agencies in eight Wisconsin counties, including Milwaukee, to supplement emergency response efforts to a major winter storm that hit the state on February 6th & 7th.
- Under the emergency declaration, Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) will provide reimbursement to local and state agencies for 75% of the total eligible costs, the State of Wisconsin will cover 12.5% and up to 1.5% for administrative costs, the remaining 12.5% is the City's share. In addition, the City is eligible to recover up to 1.5% for grant administrative costs.
- The 2008 Budget provided approximately \$4.9 million for an anticipated 3 snow plowing operations and 24 ice control operations. To date, DPW estimates that approximately \$8.9 million have been expended on 5 plowing operations and 37 ice control operations.

Discussion
