Claimant, Dineo Black, President on behalf of Dino's Contracting Service, Inc., 2821 North 4<sup>th</sup> Street, Milwaukee, WI 53212 alleges that on January 28, 2002 there was a breach of contract when the Neighborhood Improvement Development Corporation did not allow them to complete work that they had been contracted to do at 3319 North 20<sup>th</sup> Street.

Our investigation reveals that the subject matter of this claim is not the result of the operation, conduct or maintenance of the City of Milwaukee or its department, and in our view was inappropriately filed with the City. The matter pertains to the Neighborhood
