Common Council File 060557 contains the following recommendation:

Denial of the revocation request of Ms. Katina Robertson-Johnson of the Class "B" Tavern license of Kent Parker for the premises at 4001 W. Fond du Lac Ave. ("All Stars Sports Bar & Grill")

Common Council File 060817 contains the following recommendation:

Denial of a food dealer license to Edgar Birdsong, III for the premises at 5922 N. 76<sup>th</sup> St. ("Birdsong's Distribution")

Common Council File 060818 contains the following recommendation:

Denial of a food dealer license to Billy Hill for the premises at 6715 W. Villard Ave. ("The Sweet Shop")

Common Council File 060727 contains the following recommendations:

Renewal, with a 10-day suspension based on the police report and testimony at the hearing, of the Class "B" Tavern and Instrumental Music license of Tony Carter, Sr. for the premises at 2712 N. Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Drive ("Ray's Rhythm & Blues Lounge") in the 6<sup>th</sup> aldermanic district.

Renewal, with a 10-day suspension based on the police report, of the Class "B" Tavern and Tavern Dance license of John Strege, Agent for "Strege, LLC" for the premises at 9316 W. Appleton Ave. ("Side Pocket Sports Bar") in the 2<sup>nd</sup> aldermanic district. (Committee vote: Ayes: 3, Noes: 1)

Renewal of the Class "B" Tavern license with a 20-day suspension, based on the police report, of the license of Michael Nohelty for the premises at 1438 W. Lincoln Ave. ("Asti's") in the 12<sup>th</sup> aldermanic district.

Renewal of the Class "B" Tavern license with a 90-day suspension, based on the police report, of the Class "B" Tavern license of John Carter for the premises at 507 W. North Ave. ("Carter's House of Jazz") in the 6<sup>th</sup> aldermanic district. (Committee vote: Ayes: 2, Noes: 1 and Abstain: 1)

With regard to the files listed above, the Licenses Committee held an evidentiary hearing on October 30<sup>th</sup>, 2006.

Pursuant to section 68-4-10-c and section 90-11, Milwaukee Code of Ordinances, and section 125.12(12), Wis. Stats., the Committee is transmitting a copy of its Report and Recommendations, regarding the above matters to your Honorable Body.
