Allocation Purpose:

The Homeland Security Southeastern Wisconsin Threat Analysis Center (STAC) Operations 2024 grant will provide funding to continue support of the STAC, an all crimes, all threats, information sharing fusion center that serves the eight counties of Southeast Wisconsin including Milwaukee, Waukesha, Racine, Kenosha, Walworth, Ozaukee, Washington and Dodge. Funds will enhance STAC capabilities with purchases for technology software, equipment upgrades, supplies, and staff training to maintain STAC's certifications.

Program Goals:

The mission of the STAC is to gather, receive, analyze, and disseminate information and intelligence to various public and private agency partners. The STAC Operations grant will assist with enhancing collaboration, increasing information sharing, and expanding state and local efforts to identify threats and prevent terrorism and other catastrophic events.
