
This is to notify you that on July 22, 2003 the City's Utilities and Licenses Committee voted to recommend to the City's Common Council that your renewal application for a Class "A" Liquor and Malt license for the premises at 6329 South 20<sup>th</sup> Street, Milwaukee, Wisconsin ("VIP Food & Liquor Mart") be approved with a forty-five (45) day suspension. The Committee made such a recommendation based upon a police report.

On July 24, 2003, you were sent a true and correct copy of the findings of fact, conclusions of law and recommendations of the Utilities and Licenses Committee with respect to your renewal application for a Class "A" Liquor and Malt license in which the Committee recommended that your renewal application be approved with a forty-five (45) day suspension. You were further notified that the Milwaukee Common Council would consider the matter at its meeting of July 31, 2003 commencing at 9:00 a.m. in the Common Council Chambers on the third floor of City Hall, 200 East Wells Street, Milwaukee, Wisconsin. You were advised of your right to file written objections and to appear personally or by counsel to address the Common Council. At that date, time and place you did not appear, nor did you file written objections, nor were you represented by counsel.

Following consideration of the report of the Utilities and Licenses Committee, the Common Council adopted the Committee's recommendation by a vote of seventeen (17) ayes and zero (0) noes to renew the Class "A" Liquor and Malt license the licensed premises at 6329 South 20<sup>th</sup> Street, Milwaukee, Wisconsin ("VIP Food and Liquor Mart") with a forty-five (45) day suspension.

Said suspension is to be in effect between midnight, July 31, 2003 through midnight, September 13, 2003.
