File No. 061110 is a Resolution authorizing the transfer and expenditure of \$350,000 from the Neighborhood Commercial District Street Improvement Fund for the Holton Street Commercial District Enhancement Project.

### **Background**

- 1. The Department of City Development applies to the Department of Transportation for a Federal Congestion Mitigation/Air Quality (CMAQ) Program grant to support street enhancements in commercial districts.
- CMAQ grants require matches. The DCD funds the matches using Neighborhood Commecial District Streetment Improvement Fund (NCDSIF) capital improvement budgets. Fund appropriations totaled \$500,000 annually during years 2004 to 2007.

#### **Discussion**

- 1. The Department of City Development online commercial district inventory lists 56 businesses in the Holton (Reservoir north to Capital) Riverwest Commercial District.
- The District has planned enhancements along N. Holton Street from Reservoir to Center Street and designated intersections on Holton Street with Reservoir with North Avenue and Center Street such as:
  - Milwaukee Harp and Lantern Lighting
- Bicycle lanes (2 directional)

Planted street trees

- Other enhancements
- 3. This resolution allows for use of NCDSIF funds to match CMAQ awards by approving a \$350,000 transfer and expenditure from the Neighborhood Commercial District Street Improvement Fund for the aforelisted project enhancements.

## **Fiscal Impact**

As of 12/13/06, the aggregate NCDSIF fund balance available for new projects, including previous years' authority, totaled \$1,912,500, according to a FMIS query.

Adopting File 061110 authorizes a \$350,000 transfer and expenditure from the Neighbrhood Commercial Districtr Street Improvement Fund account ST04080000 to the Holton Street Commercial District Enhancement Project account, ST04083900.
