Thank you for forwarding the petitions received relating to the BID #8 expansion.

These are the same petitions that were delivered to the Planning Department on yesterday prior to the end of the deadline. The Commercial Corridor Team staff has reviewed the petitions and tallied them. According to our calculations, the valid petitions represent far less than the 40% requirements to halt the petition for expansion of the BID. These petitions represent 4% of the assessable value of the properties in the expansion area and 8% of the assessment value. Thus, in both areas they fall far short of the requirements to cease the expansion.
