1. Review and approval of the minutes of the September 27, 2010 meeting.

*Mr. Miller moved to accept minutes from the September 27, 2010 meeting.
There were no objections*

2. Department of Neighborhood Services Update.

Individuals present:

Ms. Blando present, Dept of Neighborhood Services

Mr. Tom Mishefske, Dept of Neighborhood Services - Administration

Mr. Michael McGivern, Entercom Milwaukee

Ms. Blando explained her report and charts of the Graffiti incidents reported to the Dept of Neighborhood Services (DNS) Hotline by saying that the numbers she expected to decreased from the past report, have unfortunately increased. The most dramatic increased has been the near south side, graffiti is extending into new areas; for example: College Ave and Grange Ave. It has been experience that the once graffiti is cleaned from taggers, they come back right away. Extra crews had been deployed into these areas and even the feedback from the abatement crews, concurred that the same tagger is coming back each time. There are three new taggers in the south side area.

Ald. Zielinski asked Ms. Blando are the cameras been used to apprehend these taggers?

Ms. Blando replied that the cameras are been used in different localities; the cameras installed in the south side, had been taken down for maintenance. Ms. Blando also

stated that there are two notorious taggers that were arrested; one on the east side, whose case will be coming up next year. As a way of decreasing taggers, the department is asking as part of the sentencing, that the prosecuted writes a letter of their experience.

Mr. Mishefske read a letter of one of the taggers that was arrested.

A new initiative to keep offenders from repeating their offenses or new taggers from committing graffiti, DNS is printing and publishing these letters to the students and youth on Kiss103.FM's website www.stoptaggingnow.com

Graffiti grant did receive national attention. A grant was submitted to Walmart, to cover volunteer supplies. Results will be known at the end of December. Another grant was submitted to Greater Milwaukee Foundation to make an educational video. The Illinois taggers will serve community service in Illinois and also for a couple of days doing community service during the warmer weather months in Wisconsin. They also agreed, as part of their sentencing to write a letter regarding their experience. Through Ald. Donovan new flyers were created regarding "criminal snitch but citizens tip, report a graffiti tagger". These flyers have distributed to neighbors, schools students and also the different business improvements districts.

Mr. Mishefske said that Mr. McGivern has been a great help with the anti graffiti efforts to get the word out to some of the targeted areas.

Ms. Blando introduced Mr. Michael McGivern from KissFM 103.7, in an effort to spread the word to stop tagging, Kiss 103.7 hosts a concert "Kissmas Bash 2010, Tuesday, December 7 at the RAVE. About 4000 people ages ranging from 15 - 30 years of age, to send out a message to stop tagging.

3. Police Department Update.

Officer, Michael Kuykendall, District 2

As of late summer have a high pressure water graffiti removal machine. Can not be used during winter months due to weather conditions and safety.

Several arrests have been made since last meeting, one been a high profile tagger. Police department has cleared 35 arrests, since last meeting, one of the arrests, the individual had 13 counts and the other had 7 counts; these cases are not final yet.

District two is using motion sensor cameras in the areas to detect graffiti. The two cameras in district 2 were taken down for maintenance purposes

Ald. Witkowski requested the Anti-Graffiti Policy Committee send a letter to the judges in Juvenile court advising them of the cost to the city and the impact of the population in graffiti.

4. Municipal Court Update.

Individual present:

Christine Henrichs, Chief Court Administrator

Ms. Henrichs said that cases where offenders are caught with the tools of graffiti and or the sale of these tools, have decreased. 13 cases have been filed so far this year.

Ald. Witkowski asked are the graffiti offenses going to Children court or Municipal

court?

Ms. Henrichs said that all graffiti offenses are state charges, they are handled by Circuit court. The only offenses that are Municipal offenses are either the sale or possession of the tools of graffiti.

5. Department of Public Work Update.

*Mr. Paul Novotny, DPW- Infrastructure Services, Street Operation
Mr. Novotny said that Department of Public Works (DPW) provides direct abatement with the anti-graffiti crew and also provide logistical support. The crew comes off the yard located on 35th and Capitol Dr. There are two bridge and iron painters that go out on a daily basis. Last summer DPW was using transitional employees.*

6. District's Attorney's Office Update on the status of graffiti cases.

No one present from District Attorney's office.

7. Milwaukee Christian Center Update.

Mr. Michael VanAlstain and Aaron Grant, presented update report to committee members.

Mr. Grant explained the four pages report of activities since the last meeting; the first page of the report is the association data which are the different business improvements districts that request the services from the Christian Center, the report list all the addresses of work requested and completed. Page two details all addresses received from Department of Neighborhood Services (DNS). The most obvious difference between this year and last years is the increase in market and swips; page three shows fees for service requests from individual home owner and business.

8. Updates from Business Improvement districts related to their graffiti levels and graffiti removal efforts.

*Ms. June Moberly, Avenus West Association (Business Improvement District #10)
Ms. Moberly said that the number in graffiti incidents are significant low in her area. However, graffiti is pretty consistent. Normally graffiti cost has been about \$2500.00, in 2009 jumped to over \$7000.00 dollars, that was used by July due to a very expensive hit. This year the grant was increased by 1000 dollars, but it has not been used, so far. One other thing that has been helpful, Ms. Moberly said, in keeping the graffiti removal cost low, is that several of the area business owners have removed the graffiti themselves.*

Ms. Carolyn Phoenix, Historic King Drive BID, said that since August they have not used the resources of MCC. However, there were 6 tags n a one week period, between the 2200-2600 blocks, all of them were the same tag, name and letter of DEES. Ms. Pheoenix will be reaching out to a police officer who focuses in graffiti.

9. Update from private entities receiving city funds for anti-graffiti efforts.

*Mr. James Jenkins, The Benedict Center, Community Service Coordinator
Mr. Jenkins brought in two of his crew members who participate in the graffiti removal.*

10. Discussion of new innovative ideas to improve the graffiti removal.

There was no discussion for this topic.

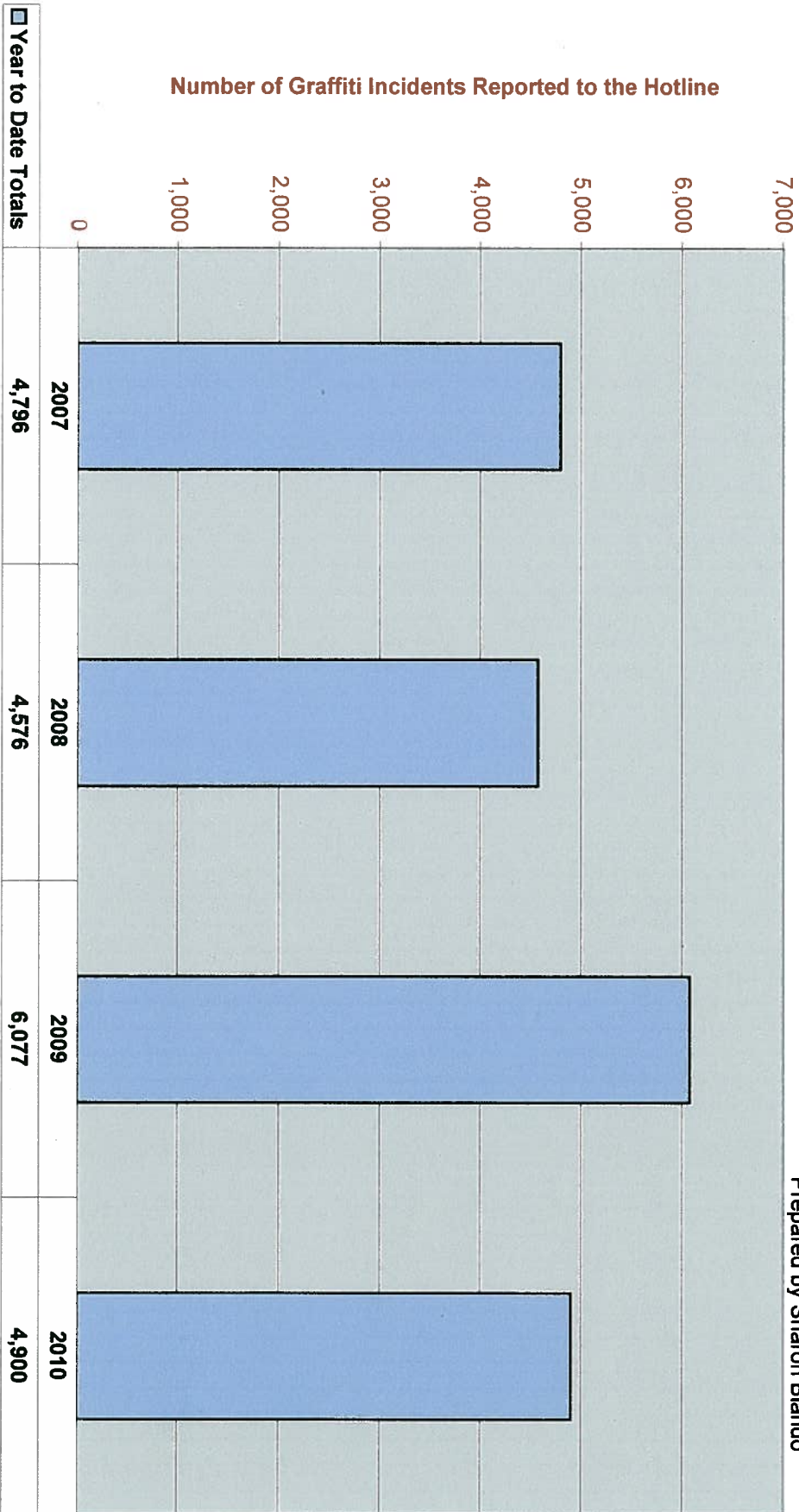

Year to Date Totals January through November 2007 to 2010

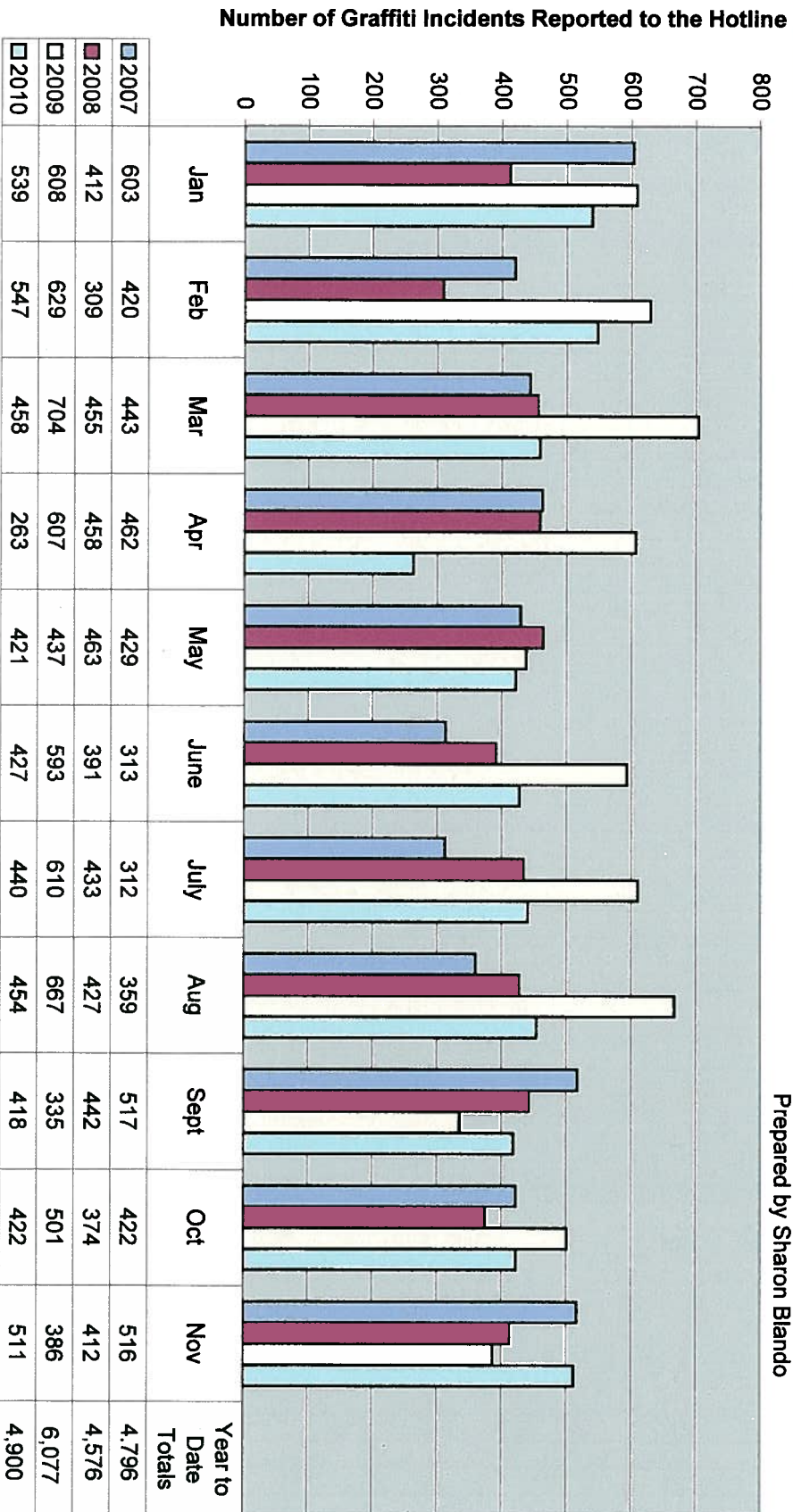

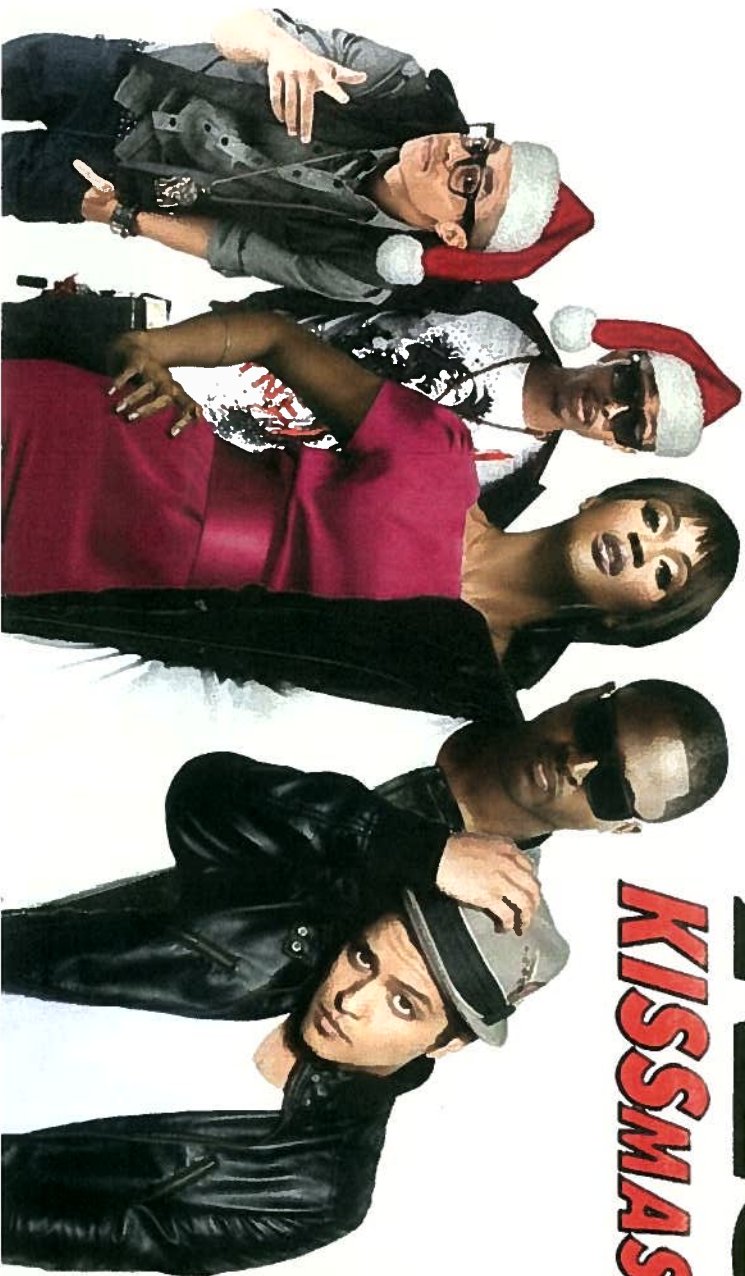

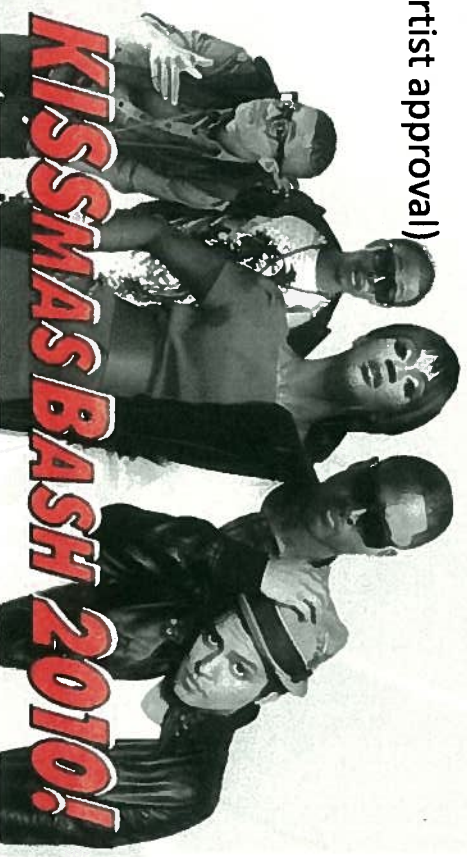

LETTER FROM A CONVICTED TAGGER:

Where to start?

My thoughts racing faster than my feet are able to run, not sure exactly how I even got in this situation in the first place but all I can seem to think is "RUN" as I about to be arrested and soon Tamed via tazer, tagged, bagged via hand cuffs that pretty much cut off all circulation, hauled via cramped cold uncomfortable cop car, and labeled criminal for something I could of avoided in the first place. So you wanna know about bombing, you wanna know about getting up, you want to know about your name being known, the rush of the chase and doing something you shouldn't. Well I'll give you the reality check of Graf in the city, this isn't a game, and when you're tazed by some hulk cop, pushing his knee into your back because he's not sure if what you have in your hand is a gun, reality will sink in as well..

About me:

at the age of 22 my grandmother passed away, my heart sank into my chest, for a week I couldn't put into words how I felt but yet my marker and paper were more than capable of letting my thoughts flow, as if lettering her name brought a sense of her back. I figured to myself after a week of drawing that I should do something on a bigger scale, something to let her name be known, street art was calling me (because I'm an idiot). It seemed harmless, and how could it effect a city, I am but one locust to the harvest. I got on my bike, bought more than enough cans, and there I was indifferent about my surroundings and empowered by my creative thought. Looking at it now a \$1000 later and so close to having my life pretty much destroyed, sometimes creative thought lacks logic.

The crime:

that is more well aware after my fiasco. I filled a backpack up with paint after previously testing my skills on an abandoned wall (which wasn't my property) I had the mind set that this rush maybe made me feel more alive than I realized. I walked about like 2 blocks from my house before pulling out a can just about to cross out a kids

tag when I thought I saw someone who I knew, walked maybe 3 steps then BAM BIKE COPS "WHAT ARE YOU DOING, DROP WHATS IN YOUR HAND" few stirred words... NOW THE FUN PART.. Being the idiot I am I ran from the cops, got tazed which is pretty terrible, taken to the hospital for the marks, then put in holding with some guys that aren't the "FRIENDLY" type. THAT NIGHT SUCKED.

REALITY CHECK TIME:

This experience isn't worth it by any means. there are so many things I think of doing now, instead of getting "UP" in the city. That \$1000 could of paid for a cheap car, 1,000 tacos from taco bell, could of paid for lots of dates, or even something that means more to my grandma. It would of paid for years of roses that I could of bought and brought to her grave. Graffiti is art and art is beautiful in itself, but there is a place for it. I sat with people who were gone for 25 years and I knew that a crime is a crime and you are but a face in the system. It's honestly not worth it and I can say first hand that after being tazed, put in jail, and gone to court for a year that I regret this more than I can even explain.. A canvas is the most beautiful thing given to a creative mind. Paint your thoughts on a canvas and not a wall. It'll make you money and save you the hassle of destroying other people's property which I didn't stress enough.. I feel like graf destroys the space that we all share. My beauty may not be everyone's beauty. think about that..

Attached for your information is the summary of vandalism and graffiti-related ordinance violations that includes information through November 30, 2010. In addition to the standard report, I have provided more a detailed listing of cases for Avandalism-graffiti related@ offenses and for cases relating to sale and possession of spray paint/wide tip markers. You will note that several of the juvenile cases have a guilty verdict but have no monetary judgment noted. This is because the juvenile was found guilty by default (they did not appear in court) and a juvenile warrant was issued for their arrest. A monetary judgment will be applied when they appear before the judge.
