Description of work

Relocation of the Christian Wahl sculpture from Harriet Tubman Park (previously named Wahl Park) to Lake Park. The sculpture, which is owned by Milwaukee County Parks, was dedicated to Wahl in 1903 and installed in Lake Park until 1960 when it was moved to its Wahl/Harriet Tubman Park. Following the 2020 rename of Harriet Tubman Park, the statue is being brought back to Lake Park for installation near the intersection of Wahl Avenue and Belleview Place in the location indicated on the attached map.
