There is a possibility that your application may be denied for one or more of the following reasons: The recommendation of the committee regarding the application shall be based on evidence presented at the hearing. Per MCO 85-4-4, unless otherwise specified in the code, probative evidence concerning non-renewal, suspension or revocation may include evidence of the following: failure of the applicant to meet municipal qualifications, pending charges against or the conviction of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the circumstances of the particular licensed or permitted activity, by the applicant or by any employee or other agent of the applicant. If the activities of the applicant involve a licensed premises, whether the premises tends to facilitate a public or private nuisance or has been the source of congregations of persons which have resulted in any of the following: disturbance of the peace; illegal drug activity; public drunkenness; drinking in public; harassment of passers-by; gambling; prostitution; sale of stolen goods; public urination; theft; assaults; battery; acts of vandalism including graffiti, excessive littering, loitering, illegal parking, loud noise at times when the licensed premise is open for business; traffic violations; curfew violations; lewd conduct; display of materials harmful to minors, pursuant to s. 106-9.6; or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety and welfare, or failure to comply with the approved plan of operation. It is the intention of the Common Council to suspend or non-renew the licenses if objectors provide testimony related to the factors enumerated in MCO 85-4-4 that the Common Council finds to be true by a preponderance of the evidence and/or police reports are found to be true by a preponderance of the evidence. The police reports and other attached documents relating to objections to the license are a part of this notice and expressly incorporated in this notice. The licensee should be prepared to address these matters at the hearing.

Proof of warrant satisfaction or payment of fines must be submitted at the hearing on the above date and time. Failure to comply with this requirement may result in a delay of the granting/denial of your application.

Failure to appear at this meeting may result in the denial of your license. Individual applicants must appear only in person or by an attorney. Corporate or Limited Liability applicants must appear only by the agent designated on the application or by an attorney. Partnership applicants must appear by a partner listed on the application or by an attorney. If you wish to do so and at your own expense, you may be accompanied by an attorney of your choosing to represent you at this hearing.

You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify. The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:

1. On 02/15/21 at 12:31pm, two unknown subjects entered the establishment and stole a firearm which was not secured and left on a business shelf, behind the counter, in sight of customers. The firearm was registered to the applicant. The employee and applicant were cooperative and gave officers video surveillance of the incident.

2. On 05/25/22 at 7:53pm, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 2847 N. Palmer Street for a trouble with subject complaint which occurred at 200 E. Center Street. Investigation revealed that a customer thought that the establishment was being robbed, so she left the location and called police. Police went to the store and found that the place was not robbed and the applicant was very cooperative.

The officer advised the cashier to have the agent contact them regarding the violation and a citation would be issued in the future.

5. On 10/09/23 at 6:22p.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Shooting at 200 E Center. Investigation revealed a suspect entered the store and attempted to purchase a tobacco product, however, the cashier refused the sale, without an ID. An argument ensued between the cashier and the suspect and the cashier called for the victim (agent's spouse) to come to the store. The victim and the suspect begin to argue and point firearms at each other. Eventually the suspect agrees to leave and the victim followed the suspect out of the store, out of camera view, however, returned with a gun shot wound to the shoulder. Officers observed blood both inside and outside the establishment. The business was cooperative with the investigation and allowed officers to view video surveillance of the incident, which depicts the incident as it was relayed to officers. The victim was a felon and should not have had a firearm.

6. On 02/21/25 at 8:15p.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Threat at 200 E. Center St. Investigation revealed a subject was purchasing items and the cashier made an error when ringing up the purchase, which caused an argument between the two. The cashier called the owner and the owner used vulgar language and threatened to harm the customer if she took the items. The customer grabbed the bag and left the store. While the officer was on scene they observed transactions for alcohol and tobacco purchases taking place, without verifying age. The officer advised the employees of the violation.

On Saturday, 10-04-25, I along with coordinator Edgar Mendez from Jump at the Sun Consultants conducted a Wisconsin WINS Tobacco Prevention compliance check. Assisting were a 17-year-old female (TA' Niyah Shamon Sanders, B/F 07/05/08, 3514 N. 13th St.) and a 16-year-old male (Malik Hughes B/M 05/18/09, 2725 N. 11th St.). Both of them had a WI Id's Card that indicated their dates of births. Both are under the legal age to purchase a tobacco product.

They were instructed to walk into a business together and one of them would attempt to purchase a tobacco product. If the store employee asked for their ID card, they would present the employee with it. If the store employee did not ask for an ID Card, they would not present an ID Card. The legal age to purchase tobacco is 21 years old in the State of Wisconsin, 18 in Milwaukee.

At 10:48 AM, both Sanders and Hughes walked into Palmer Center Foods located at 200 E. Center St. Hughes asked a cashier for a tobacco product and was served without them verifying his age.

THE described Cashier / SELLER, MIDDLE EASTERN YOUNGER FEMALE, PINK SHIRT WITH BLACK AND WHITE STRIPES, BLACK HAIR IN A PONY TAIL.

At 10 :57 AM, the cashier was identified as Monika Chirrapa, Address: 2222 E. Belveiw#101 Milwaukee, WI, Phone: 414-553-9566. I advised they sold a Black and Mild Cigar containing tobacco to a minor and never asked to see WI ID card to verify Hughes was the legal age to purchase the item before conducting a sale. Chirrapa, never denied that she failed to ask for a WI ID Card. She also never denied selling the Black and Mild Cigar. Chirrapa stated she didn't know they were minors, and made a mistake.

I ended with providing my contact information. The agent will be called and advised of the citation with attempts to deviled or mail to their listed address if personal delivery is unsuccessful.

There were no other employees inside the store at the time of this incident.

I did not view the surveillance video.

The store's agent will be notified by phone and he/she might be receiving a citation in the mail regarding this investigation. The determination will be based on the whether or not the store agent attends a meeting with the State of Wisconsin agents at a later date.

Those wishing to provide oral testimony via internet are asked to contact the staff assistant, Yadira Melendez at (414) 286-2775 or stasst5@milwaukee.gov for necessary information. Please make such requests no later than one business day prior to the start of the meeting. You are not required to attend the hearing, but please see the information below if you would like to provide testimony. Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing.

Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)
6. You may then provide testimony.
 - a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
 - b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
 - c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
 - d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.
Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.
