The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:

This report is written by Police Officer Penny Monreal, assigned to the License Investigation Unit,

- 1. On 04/06/22, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Shots Fired complaint at 4707 W. Mill Rd. Officers were advised by security they heard multiple shots coming from the area. Officers recovered casings near they parking lot and along the sidewalk area between 47-49th St. The owner advised officers they would be able to view video surveillance on 04/08/22.
- 2. On 05/02/22, Milwaukee Police conducted a meeting with the agent for Coconut Bowling Alley, located at 4707 W. Mill Rd. This was due to the Shots Fired incident on 04/06/22. The agent was cooperative and has complied with changes that were suggested at the meeting, and has hired additional security.

3. On 12/26/22 at 9:56p.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Trouble with Subject at 4707 W. Mill Rd. Investigation revealed patrons entered the business and were observed taking a bottle of alcohol out of a jacket. Security approached the subjects and advised them they cannot bring alcohol into the establishment and they were too young to consume alcohol. The individuals were advised they had to leave the premise at which time a patron began to physically struggle with security. The patrons were eventually all escorted out with no further incident.

- 4. On 03/04/23 at 9:41p.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Subject with Gun at 4707 W. Mill Rd. The officers were advised by security and the agent a patron was leaving the establishment and pulled a gun out, aiming it at the ceiling and made a statement to shoot up the business. The officers interviewed several patrons in an attempt to identify the individual, however, everyone denied knowing the subject's name. The agent was cooperative with the investigation and stated they would upload video surveillance of the incident for officers to view.
- 5. On 03/29/23 at 7:45p.m, Milwaukee Police conducted a License Premise Check at 4707 W. Mill Rd. On arrival officers were met by the manager who advised officers of additional security measures they added to ensure safety of the employees and patrons. The business added exterior LED lights, 5 exterior security cameras and hired an additional two security officers to assist on the weekends.

NATURE OF CALL/ JUSTIFICATION

On Monday, December 26, 2022 at approximately 9:56 pm, PO Khalid MAJEED and I (Squad 4467) responded to a Trouble with Subject complaint located at the address of 4707 W Mill Rd which is the Coconut Bowling Alley. This address is located in both the City and County of Milwaukee, WI.

INVESTIGATION

PO MAJEED and I were patrolling the area near 47th and W Mill Rd where we were flagged down by Gentle J. DILLS (B/M 04/22/1984) who is employed at the Coconut Bowling alley as a security guard. DILLS stated that there was a small altercation inside of the business where a male and a female were removed from the building for causing a disturbance. PO MAJEED and I parked our fully marked squad in front of the main entrance of the business.

I observed a black male wearing a red sweatshirt and blue jean pants standing in the parking lot in front of the main entrance. The male, later identified as Gerrone Z. LAWSON (B/M 08/03/2004) was identified by DILL as one of the individuals who were asked to leave the business. DILL stated that LAWSON was with a female, later identified as Jakira E. LUCUS (B/F 10/17/2003), who were patrons of the business.

DILL stated that on this day, LUCUS and LAWSON entered the bowling alley and was check by security by use of a hand held metal detector. DILL stated that LUCUS and LAWSON were in the company of two other unidentified females when they entered the building. DILL stated that LUCUS and the two females entered the female restroom where an employee observed the females removing a bottle of alcohol from the liner of a coat. DILL stated that he was informed about the liquor and approached the females as the exited the bathroom. DILL stated that he informed the females that no one can bring alcohol into the establishment and an argument began between the security and the females. Delroy A. PERRIN heard the confrontation and attempted to speak to the group of females. PERRIN stated that alcoholic beverages can not be brought into the business and also that LUCUS and LAWSON were too young to legally consume alcohol. PERRIN stated that the group of individuals had to leave the premise in which LUCUS began to physically struggle with DILL. LAWSON also struggled with DILL as he escorted LUCUS and the other two females out of the building. PERRIN and DILL stated that they were able to remove the individuals from the building without further incident.

LAWSON and LUCUS was located in the parking lot and disclosed their information to officers. LAWSON and LUCUS was informed that they were not allowed back inside of the business per PERRIN. A check in department records revealed that LAWSON and LUCUS was not wanted by authorities.

Officers did not located any bottles of alcohol in the parking lot of the business and LAWSON and LUCUS denied having any alcohol.

LAWSON and LUCUS was picked up by an acquaintance and departed the scene without further incident.

This report is written by P.O. Jesse SAENPHONPHAKDEE, assigned to District four, Early Shift, Squad 4231 with P.O. Mathew DEGLEY.

On Saturday March 4, 2023, at approximately 9:41 PM, P.O. DEGLEY and I were dispatched to 4704 W. Mill Rd which is located in the City and County of Milwaukee, WI for a subject with gun complaint.

On arrival officers spoke to the caller/owner of the of the business, Delroy A. PERRIN (B/M, 08/08/73) who stated there was a subject at his business who threatened to shoot up the business as he was advised by security personnel and his wife.

Thereafter, I spoke to security personnel Kraig S. THOMAS (B/M, 01/20/79) who stated he was standing near the front of the entrance with the owner, Pamela D. PERRIN (B/F, 08/18/79). While conversing with Pamela, THOMAS stated he observed a black male, approximately 18 years old to his mid 20s wearing all black concealing a firearm in his waistband. THOMAS stated the subject appeared he was leaving the facility but turned around and waved a firearm towards the ceiling stating "I'll shoot this motherfucker up". THOMAS then stated the subject left the premise.

I then spoke to Pamela who observed the incident as well which she stated she was just talking to THOMAS and observed a black male wearing all black walk pass as if he was going to leave the premise. Pamela stated as the subject walked pass, he turned around and displayed a firearm stating, "I'll shoot this motherfucker up".

Pamela stated the subject was at the establishment for a birthday party that started at 6:00 PM and believes he was there the whole time.

Officers attempted to speak to individuals who may know the subject as they attended the same birthday party, but no one knew his name.

There was video surveillance on scene that captured the incident which Delroy will be submitting the evidence through evidence.com.

PERRIN stated that the new cameras as well as the new lighting will aide with securing the business and also protect his employees and patrons. PERRIN stated that he has added two additional security guards on the weekends.



Please make such requests no later than one business day prior to the start of the meeting. You are not required to attend the hearing, but please see the information below if you would like to provide testimony. Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing.

Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

- 1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
- 2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
- 3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
- 4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
- 5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)

- 6. You may then provide testimony.
- a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
- b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
- c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
- d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
- 7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
- 8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license
