The purpose of the grant is to allow the MHD to conduct a survey of local physicians on their knowledge of antiviral distribution and dispensing and increase the education to those healthcare providers on how to appropriately and effectively dispense antiviral medications during seasonal and possible pandemic influenza outbreaks. The target population is the City of Milwaukee healthcare community.

2. Relationship to City-Wide Strategic Goals and Departmental Objectives:

The project goal related to the core public health goal of communicable disease control and prevention

3. Need for Grant Funds and Impact on Other Departmental Operations (Applies only to Programs):

Funding will increase the effectiveness of MHD to assist private healthcare in operationally deploying antiviral medications during seasonal or pandemic influenza season, which is currently not being funded under other grants
