The above-named police officers have retained us to represent them in connection with the above-referenced matter. The officers were also represented by another law firm (Eggert Law Office, S.C.) which has submitted a separate bill to you regarding this matter.

Consistent with its policy, the City Attorney's Office has refused to represent them and as they were performing the duties of their office at the time of the events giving rise to the incident, the claim is hereby made on their behalf for the indicated legal fees. This incident involved a juvenile arrest at a district station. The Fire and Police Commission dismissed the complaint. Attached is a copy of the dismissal notice.






