File Number 060978 is a resolution relating to application for, and acceptance and funding of, a 2006 COPS Secure Our Schools Grant, and authorization of a sub-grant to Milwaukee Public Schools for school security measures.

Background

- 1. The U.S. Department of Justice, Community Oriented Policing Services, offers the COPS Secure Our Schools Grant to fund security improvements in and around schools.
- 2. This is a pass-through grant i.e., the Milwaukee Police Department applies for the grant on behalf of Milwaukee Public Schools and sub-grants the grant funds to MPS.
- 3. The Police Department received a 2005 COPS Secure Our Schools Grant in the amount of \$536,411. Milwaukee Public Schools used this money to purchase security cameras and related support equipment.

Discussion

- 1. This grant is awarded to MPS based upon application for the grant by a local law enforcement agency (namely, the Milwaukee Police Department). MPS uses a consultant to assist with the placement of security equipment in selected MPS facilities.
- 2. Milwaukee Public Schools and the City of Milwaukee will execute a memorandum of understanding governing the sub-granting of these grant funds to MPS.
- 3. The grant period extends from September 1, 2006, through August 31, 2008.

Fiscal Impact

- 1. The total cost of this grant-funded project is \$689,722, of which \$344,861 (50%) will be provided by the grantor and sub-granted by the City to MPS. Milwaukee Public Schools must provide the remaining \$344,861 (50%) of project cots.
- 2. Milwaukee Public Schools will use these funds to purchase security equipment for school buildings (primarily security cameras and related equipment).
