There is a possibility that your application may be denied for one or more of the following reasons: The recommendation of the committee regarding the application shall be based on evidence presented at the hearing. Per MCO 85-4-4, unless otherwise specified in the code, probative evidence concerning non-renewal, suspension or revocation may include evidence of the following: failure of the applicant to meet municipal qualifications, pending charges against or the conviction of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the circumstances of the particular licensed or permitted activity, by the applicant or by any employee or other agent of the applicant. If the activities of the applicant involve a licensed premises, whether the premises tends to facilitate a public or private nuisance or has been the source of congregations of persons which have resulted in any of the following: disturbance of the peace; illegal drug activity; public drunkenness; drinking in public; harassment of passers-by; gambling; prostitution; sale of stolen goods; public urination; theft; assaults; battery; acts of vandalism including graffiti, excessive littering, loitering, illegal parking, loud noise at times when the licensed premise is open for business; traffic violations; curfew violations; lewd conduct; display of materials harmful to minors, pursuant to s. 106-9.6; or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety and welfare, or failure to comply with the approved plan of operation. It is the intention of the Common Council to suspend or non-renew the licenses if objectors provide testimony related to the factors enumerated in MCO 85-4-4 that the Common Council finds to be true by a preponderance of the evidence and/or police reports are found to be true by a preponderance of the evidence. The police reports and other attached documents relating to objections to the license are a part of this notice and expressly incorporated in this notice. The licensee should be prepared to address these matters at the hearing.

**Notice for applicants with
warrants or unpaid fines:**

Proof of warrant satisfaction or payment of fines must be submitted at the hearing on the above date and time. Failure to comply with this requirement may result in a delay of the granting/denial of your application.

Failure to appear at this meeting may result in the denial of your license. Individual applicants must appear only in person or by an attorney. Corporate or Limited Liability applicants must appear only by the agent designated on the application or by an attorney. Partnership applicants must appear by a partner listed on the application or by an attorney. If you wish to do so and at your own expense, you may be accompanied by an attorney of your choosing to represent you at this hearing.

You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify. You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. If you have difficulty with the English language, you should bring an interpreter with you, at your expense, so that you can answer questions and participate in your hearing.

You may examine the application file at this office during regular business hours prior to the hearing date. Inquiries regarding this matter may be directed to the person whose signature appears below.

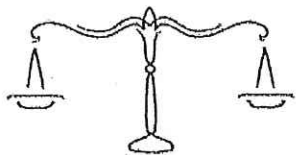

Re: False Complaints Against Silk Exotic

I represent Silk Exotic, which holds three liquor licenses in Milwaukee, Wisconsin. It came to our attention that you have filed false complaints against my client, as they employ a prostitute named Mandy. These allegations are entirely baseless and defamatory.

Under Wisconsin law, defamation, including both slander and libel, is a serious offense. Wisconsin Statutes § 942.01 states that anyone who, with intent to defame, communicates any defamatory matter to a third person without the consent of the person defamed is guilty of a Class A misdemeanor. This offense is punishable by up to \$10,000 and/or imprisonment for up to nine months.

Furthermore, knowingly filing false complaints can also be considered a violation of Wisconsin Statutes § 946.66, which addresses false complaints against law enforcement officers but sets a precedent for the seriousness of filing false complaints.

Your actions have caused significant harm to my client's reputation and business operations. Therefore, we demand that you immediately retract your false statements in writing to the City of Milwaukee within three (3) days of receiving this letter. Failure to comply will result in legal action against you for defamation and any other applicable charges. Additionally, if a retraction is not received within the specified timeframe, we will proceed to file a formal complaint with law enforcement authorities.

This letter serves as a formal notice and demand for retraction. We trust that you will take this matter seriously and act accordingly to avoid further legal consequences.

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4. On 06/04/09 at 1:47 am, Milwaukee police were dispatched to 11400 W Silver Spring for a Battery complaint. Police spoke to the victim who stated she was at Silk when another patron came up to her spat in her face and also made threats to harm her. Security removed the suspect from the tavern and officers issued the suspect a citation for disorderly conduct.

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5. On 04/21/12 at 2:24 pm, Milwaukee police investigated an accident complaint at 11400 W Silver Spring Drive. Investigation revealed a patron had damage done to his auto while he was inside the club. Police spoke with management who stated that the car was parked out of surveillance range and did not capture this incident. A report was filed.

6. On 05/13/12, Milwaukee police conducted a License Premise Check and found no violations.

7. On 05/19/12 at 2:15 am, Milwaukee police conducted a License Premise Check and found no violations.

8. On 07/06/12 at 12:20 am, Milwaukee police responded to a Battery complaint at 11400 W Silver Spring. Investigation revealed an employee, who was highly intoxicated, was causing a disturbance and had slapped two patrons inside the club. Other club employees' took the subject to a back room and attempted to call her a cab, but the subject refused and left on her own, falling several times. A security guard filmed some of the incident on his cell phone, which was played for police. Police did speak with the subject who refused to talk with police and hung up on the officer. There were no recording surveillance cameras inside the establishment.

9. On 09/01/12 at 1:15 am, Milwaukee police conducted a License Premise Check at 11400 W Silver Spring. No violations were observed.

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10. On 01/01/2015 occupants of a vehicle responded to Silk to pick up an individual that was an employee there. One of the occupants of the vehicle commanded a dog in the car to attack the person they had just picked up. The victim was able to exit the vehicle and ran back into Silk. An armed Security Guard employed by Silk Exotic fired a handgun at the dog. The Investigation revealed the Security Guard, Laderle R. Williams, is a convicted felon from a case on 12/05/14 and was prohibited from possessing a gun. Members of District Four had a meeting with Jon Ferraro regarding this incident. Mr. Ferraro stated he hired the security guard nine years ago and fired him once he was informed by the police. Milwaukee police incident report #150130080 filed.
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11. On 04/24/2015 Milwaukee police, along with agents from the Department of Revenue, Health Department and Department of Neighborhood Services, conducted a tavern check at 11400 West Silver Spring Road (Silk Exotic Adult Entertainment Night Club). During this check, 16 bottles of alcohol were disposed of for various health infractions.
12. On 12/13/2015 Milwaukee police responded to a subject with a weapon complaint at 11400 West Silver Spring Road (Silk Exotic Milwaukee Gentleman Club). Officers spoke to Montel Jackson and Perry Wilk, who identified themselves as contracted security officers for Silk Exotic Milwaukee Gentleman Club. Wilk stated approximately 10 Asian males and one Asian female were denied access into the establishment because they were not in compliance with the dress code. He also believed they were associated with the Asian Crips. Jackson told officers that a group of subjects was pushed out of the business by patrons and security. Two of the members of this group returned to their autos and retrieved handguns, which they fired approximately 6 times. Milwaukee police incident report #153470007 filed.
13. On 01/07/2016 Milwaukee police met with Jon Ferraro regarding the shots fired incident described in item #12. Mr. Ferraro stated the club will be repairing and putting cameras in the parking lot and he is willing to work with Milwaukee police to keep the business safe.

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14. On 04/29/2016 at 2:03am officers were dispatched to Silk Exotic, 11400 W. Silver Spring Dr for a battery complaint. Upon arrival the officer spoke with security who stated there was a verbal argument in the lot at about 1:50am. He stated he told the parties to leave and they got in their cars and left.
15. On 01/15/2017 officers responded to Showtime Sports Bar, 11400 W. Silver Spring Dr for a shooting. The officers found MFD working on the victim in the parking lot. The victim had a gunshot wound to the stomach. The victim was conveyed to the hospital and refused to cooperate with the officers. Security of the bar was cooperative and supplied the video from inside and outside the bar. The officers observed the victim and the suspect in the bar prior to the shooting. Milwaukee Police Department IR# 17-012-0148 filed.
16. On 01/27/2017 the applicant was charged in Waukesha County with Illegal Games/Gambling (Forfeiture).

17. On 09/22/2017 at 1:56am officers were dispatched to an accident at Silk, 11400 W. Silver Spring Dr. The investigation revealed the accident was a hit and run with the striking auto hitting a pedestrian and fleeing the scene. The owner, Craig PLOETZ, was on scene but did not know how to operate the video system. The officer returned on 09/23/2017 and the manager provided officers with a copy of the footage and a name of the driver of the striking auto.
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18. On 01/09/2019 at 2:15am officers were dispatched to a battery at Silk Exotic, 11400 W. Silver Spring Dr. The officers interviewed the intoxicated caller, Tyler BOCHMAN, who stated he was battery by security. The officer spoke with security who stated they were asking BOCHMAN to leave because the business was closed. BOCHMAN attempted to re-enter the business and the security guard put up his arm to stop BOCHMAN, which caused him to fall to the ground. The officer spoke with two witnesses who stated the security guard was just attempting to stop BOCHMAN from re-entering the closed business.

19. On 03/06/2019 at 1:44am officers were dispatched to a Trouble with Subject at Silk, 11400 W. Silver Spring Dr. The officer met the caller, Christopher WASHBURN, at the Mobil gas station. He stated he was threatened by security at Silk. He would not say exactly what happened. The officer interviewed security who stated WASHBURN is regular and causes problems at closing time. They said he was advised the business was closing soon and he became uncooperative so he was denied entry.

20. On 04/14/2019 officers were dispatched to a Sexual Assault at Rock Country Bar, 11400 W. Silver Spring Dr. The caller stated that she was at the bar and an unknown male grabbed her butt and squeezed it several times. She then punched the male 3 to 4 times. The officers spoke with the manager, Craig PLOETZ, who stated he heard patrons saying the victim was intoxicated and may have bumped into another patron.

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21. On 01/25/2020 at 12:49ma officers were dispatched to Silk Exotic, 11400 W. Silver Spring Dr, for a Battery complaint. The officer spoke with an employee, who stated a subject was ask to leave and was being disorderly. The subject was waiting for his ride in the lobby and was trash talking other patrons. The subject then attempted to punch another patron but hit the employee knocking his glasses off. The subject was then placed outside to wait for his brother to pick him up. The employee was not injured and did not want to prosecute.

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22. On 11/29/20 at 11:45pm, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 11400 W. Silver Spring Road for an entry into auto complaint. Investigation reveals that two vehicles were broken into but nothing was taken. Video surveillance captured the incidents and security was able to provide officers with the registration plate of the suspects vehicle.

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23. On 01/22/23 at 1:48am, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 11400 W. Silver Spring Road for a subject with gun complaint. Officers spoke with the caller who was taken out of business, by security. The caller stated that he wanted to press charges on the business after being attacked by security and having a gun pointed at him. The caller was initially uncooperative with investigating officers and requested to speak with a police supervisor. Once the supervisor arrived the caller gave his information and his account of what occurred. On the night of the assignment, officers spoke with business agent who stated that the business has a policy where significant others of entertainers are not allowed to be at the location, if the entertainer is on the work schedule. Once staff was aware that the caller, who is the boyfriend of one of the entertainers was identified he was asked to leave. The caller became aggressive and caused a disturbance when being escorted out, even striking some security staff. Officers conducted follow up on 01/23/23 regarding video footage, and speaking with the bar tender that was on duty. Officers did not observe the armed security pull out or unholster their firearm

during the incident. After reviewing the video and speaking with staff, officers cited the caller for his actions regarding the incident.

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24. On 05/23/23 at 2:49a.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Threat at 11400 W. Silver Spring Dr. Officers were advised a subject was refusing to leave and making derogatory comments about the employees. The subject was eventually picked up and the employees were cooperative.

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25. On 08/18/24 at 1230am., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Theft at 11400 W Silver Spring Dr. Investigation revealed the victim's vehicle was taken from the parking lot. The business was cooperative with the investigation and allowed officers to view video surveillance of the incident.

This supplemental report is submitted by Police Officer Shane Bishop assigned to District Four, Late Power Shift, Squad 4431 with Police Officer Ashley Pashkewitz.

On Sunday, August 18th, 2024, Squad 4431 volunteered to respond to a "Theft" complaint at the location of 11400 West Silver Spring Road. The caller was reporting his vehicle stolen.

On arrival, officers located the caller/victim standing in front of the business, Silk Exotic Gentlemen's Club Exotic. The caller, verbally identified as Michael J Arroyo w/m 08-31-1984, stated his vehicle had been stolen from the parking lot of the location and physically pointed out where he had parked.

Arroyo stated he arrived at the location at approximately 10:00pm, 08-17-2024, and discovered his vehicle stolen around 12:30am, 08-18-2024. No broken glass was located on scene.

The stolen vehicle was described by Arroyo as a charcoal gray in color 2014 Dodge Charger. Arroyo stated the vehicle has a rear front Wisconsin registration plate 337-YVM displayed however the front plate is currently in the glove compartment. There was no other external distinct characteristics described for the vehicle. Inside the vehicle was a gray and pink child's seat in the rear driver side seat area. Inside the trunk was Green Bay Packer posters and fold up chairs. The vin number of the vehicle was provided 2C3CDXDT1EH244648. Arroyo has Secura insurance for this vehicle.

Regarding the vehicle theft, Arroyo believed he had his vehicle keys on his person however the keys were unaccounted for. The location of the keys are unknown. Arroyo believed the keys were on his person upon arrival at the business.

Officers made contact with the management of the business. The business does have functioning exterior video cameras at location which do face the parking lot area. According to management, video

depicts two unknown subjects walking on foot from the west to Arroyo's vehicle. The subjects enter the vehicle and it's observed driving away eastbound. Police Officer Pashkewitz coordinated with the manager to obtain video of this incident and have the video e-mailed to officers.

Arroyo was provided a PV-17 form (Milwaukee Police Department Crime Victim Resources form) with officer's contact information and related case number. Arroyo did sign and complete a Milwaukee Police Department Vehicle Theft Supplementary Report form scene. No physical witnesses were located per se however there was video of the incident.

Without a vehicle, Arroyo was stranded at the location. Officers were able to provide Arroyo a ride, to his residence with the approval of District Four acting shift commander, Sgt. Kenneth Ma.

On 04-16-2025, I was contacted via e-mail and requested to file license premise report for above location regarding vehicle theft that occurred in parking lot on August 18th, 2024.

The above application has been made by the above named applicant(s). This requires approval from the Licenses Committee and the Common Council of the City of Milwaukee. The hearing before the Licenses Committee will take place on 7/22/2025 at 11:15 AM in Room 301-B, Third Floor, City Hall. This is a public hearing. Those wishing to view the proceeding are able to do so via the City Channel – Channel 25 on Spectrum Cable – or on the Internet at <http://city.milwaukee.gov/citychannel>. Those wishing to provide oral testimony via internet are asked to contact the staff assistant, Yadira Melendez at (414) 286-2775 or stasst5@milwaukee.gov for necessary information. Please make such requests no later than one business day prior to the start of the meeting. You are not required to attend the hearing, but please see the information below if you would like to provide testimony. Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing.

Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)
6. You may then provide testimony.
 - a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
 - b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.

 - d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.


