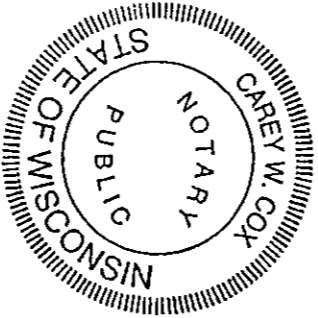

for a total estimated cost of
\$1,320,200.

for this project including the requested
amount is \$153,000. This project is an-
ticipated to be completed during the
2008 construction season.
