Dear Sir/Madam:

I am writing to request a hearing in order to appeal the denial of my claim for damage incurred when my vehicle was towed on January 15, 2005.

There is a large dent on the lower side of the rear left wing of my vehicle that was clearly created by this tow. During a brief out of town visit, my vehicle which had full parking permits, was towed from the street in front of my residence due to un-posted city ordinance for parking in Excess of 24 hours. (I am new to Milwaukee and appealed the parking fine for this, which the clerk kindly reduced.) However, I am absolutely certain that there was no dent on that right wing when I parked the vehicle, and it is impossible that it was created during my absence, as it was on the sidewalk side of the vehicle, and such a dent could not have been created by a pedestrian.

I would greatly appreciate it if you could grant me a hearing. I would like to consult, if possible, as well as ask for a reevaluation the PT-27 form.

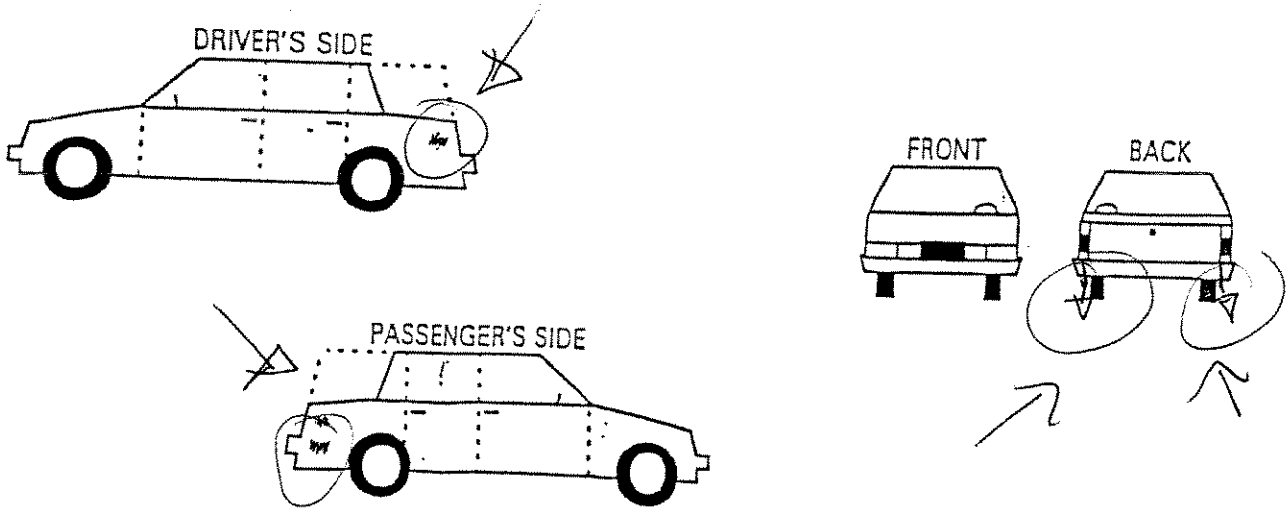
