Per MCO 85-4-4, unless otherwise specified in the code, probative evidence concerning non-renewal, suspension or revocation may include evidence of the following: failure of the applicant to meet municipal qualifications, pending charges against or the conviction of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the circumstances of the particular licensed or permitted activity, by the applicant or by any employee or other agent of the applicant. If the activities of the applicant involve a licensed premises, whether the premises tends to facilitate a public or private nuisance or has been the source of congregations of persons which have resulted in any of the following: disturbance of the peace; illegal drug activity; public drunkenness; drinking in public; harassment of passers-by; gambling; prostitution; sale of stolen goods; public urination; theft; assaults; battery; acts of vandalism including graffiti, excessive littering, loitering, illegal parking, loud noise at times when the licensed premise is open for business; traffic violations; curfew violations; lewd conduct; display of materials harmful to minors, pursuant to s. 106-9.6; or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety and welfare, or failure to comply with the approved plan of operation. The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:

1. On 12/11/2004 at 5:20 PM the applicant was cited for Sale to Underage at 601 E Bolivar Av. No further information.

2. On 06/25/2005 at 9:46PM officers responded to the licensed premises at 601 E Bolivar regarding a disturbance involving 15 juveniles. The complainant related that there were 15 juveniles drinking and causing a disturbance. Upon arrival officers observed some of the juveniles run into the back yard of the tavern. Officers also observed juveniles run into the back door of the tavern. The bartender on the scene, Eileen BRATEL, the ex-wife of the applicant, appeared to be intoxicated herself. She yelled at officers saying they had no business in the back hall of the tavern. Further investigation revealed that 8-juveniles had been drinking. All were cited. The bartender was taken into custody after she attempted to hit one of the investigating officers with an object she retrieved from behind the bar. The bartender continued to yell and swear at officers as she was escorted out of the tavern. The applicant, who was out of town was contacted. He related that the bartender was his ex-wife for a reason. That her mouth was always getting her into trouble and that she thinks she is above the law. ______

- 3. On 03/28/2020 officers conducted a license premise check at Gator's Pub, 601 E. Bolivar Av, regarding complaints at the business for violations of the Governor's emergency orders. The officers located the wife of the owner inside the business. The applicant was also on scene and stated the business is open for carry out only. The officer spoke with the caller who stated there were 4-5 people inside prior to the officer's arrival.
- 4. On 07/22/2020 officers conducted a license premise check at Gator's Pub, 601 E. Bolivar Av, regarding complaints the business was over serving patrons. The officer talked with the bartender, who stated she does not serve people she believes has had too much to drink. The applicant was on scene and stated that some of his regular patrons are elderly and have trouble walking so they may have been mistaken for being over served.

- 5. On 11/29/20 at 10:30pm, Milwaukee Police conducted a license premise check at 601 E. Bolivar Avenue. Officers found no violations and the employee was cooperative during the interaction.

This report is written by PO Edgar RODRIGUEZ, assigned to District 6 Early Shift on Squad 6240.

On (01/26/2025) at 4:26 PM I was dispatched to a battery at Gators Bar located at 601 E Bolivar in the City and County of Milwaukee.

Upon arrival I spoke to the caller who was a patron who stated he was assaulted by another patron who is known to him. Both the caller and subject are regulars at the bar.

I did observe minor redness to the caller's face but medical was not needed.

The caller identified as CHAPPEL, Carl E (M/W 06/29/68) stated that another male subject identified as SHEPPE, Daniel J (M/W 04/09/70) made a statement about him being divorced after an argument over a song on the jukebox. Carl stated he went to confront SHEPPE about the comment and then was struck one in the face by a closed fist.

Squad 6220 arrived on Scene and assisted me with this investigation.

I then spoke to patrons in the bar who were not identified. The patrons stated that Carl was the primary aggressor and SHEPPE was defending himself.

I then spoke to SHEPPE who stated that Carl was arguing with another patron about the music in the jukebox. SHEPPE stated that he asked Carl to settle down, and a back-and-forth argument started between the two. SHEPPE stated that he made a comment about Carl's divorce, and this set Carl off. Carl got in SHEPPES face and grabbed him by his shirt. SHEPPE stated he got up and punched Carl in the face one time. This stopped the fight and Carl called 911. SHEPPE did not wish to be a victim of any crime. After speaking with Carl, he also did not wish to press charges.

I briefly spoke to the bartender who stated that Carl was the primary aggressor

The hearing before the Licenses Committee will take place on 11/11/2025 at 2:45 PM in Room 301-B, Third Floor, City Hall. This is a public hearing. Those wishing to view the proceeding are able to do so via the City Channel – Channel 25 on Spectrum Cable – or on the Internet at http://city.milwaukee.gov/citychannel. Those wishing to provide oral testimony via internet are asked to contact the staff assistant, Yadira Melendez at (414) 286-2775 or stasst5@milwaukee.gov for necessary information. Please make such requests no later than one business day prior to the start of the meeting. You are not required to attend the hearing, but please see the information below if you would like to provide testimony. Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing.

Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

- 1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
- 2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
- 3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
- 4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
- 5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)

- 6. You may then provide testimony.
- a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
- b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
- c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
- d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
- 7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
- 8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.

Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.
