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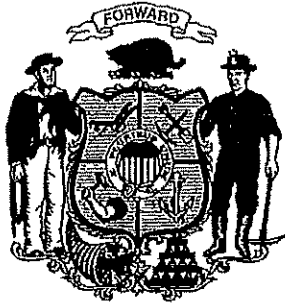





Niko presented me with a contract and signed scope of work with deadlines and payments to be made and promised the work would be completed as long as pymts were all made on time. All monies and pymts were made on time. I found out that he was not purchasing any ~~and~~ items we picked out at Menards and he wasn't going to house to complete work. He only put up ~~daywall~~ and after a year and a half almost two put damaged goods and dropped off tub (5ft not 7ft as agreed) and someone gave him a refurbished furnace and supplies and left in my basement. He has given me some receipts but nothing has been completed work on 10th street and incomplete work on 10th street. It's been two plus years - I have to deal with inspections and trusting new city contractors now.
