Proposal This application involves three components. First, the applicant seeks approval for

exterior signage on the side of the building and the replacement of the existing La Perla sign with a new sign. Secondly, the applicant seeks approval for existing awnings and awning signage. Lastly, the applicant seeks to address the violation order received regarding window signage and plans to address the signage that

exceeds 25% of glazed area.

Staff comments The business has been open since approximately 2017. It went into operation

without obtaining an occupancy permit or acquiring any sign permits.

By staff's analysis, nearly every existing sign requires a variance. Therefore, it seems unwise for this body to rule on appropriateness before the issue of variances

is settled.

Non-allowable features per zoning

295-407-9-h Abandoned signs are prohibited (business has not existed for greater than 90 days). La Perla sign on west elevation and V100 sign beneath large vinyl banner. The V100 sign is arguably abandoned as the branding used in the signage

is not current.

295-407-2-b-7a

Window signs may not cover more than 25% of window area. This is true of all

window signs except the main entry door.

Vinyl banner signs are prohibited. Criteria for exceptions are not met.

295-705-7-b-1. Awning Signs. b-1-a. "The sign shall be not more than 12 inches in height." All of the awnings contain a signage component that is taller than 12 inches.

It is likely that the awnings over the sidewalk require a right of way permit.

As the signs are not compliant with zoning, this application should be denied on those grounds or the application should be held until the applicants have gone

through the variance process.
