This creates an unsafe situation for westbound U-turning vehicles that are entering the intersection at the end of the westbound green or during the yellow indication. Therefore, we recommend the installation of signs prohibiting westbound U-turns on West Lloyd Street at North Sherman Boulevard.

We will prepare the necessary legislation that will be heard at the next Public Safety Committee meeting, so you may support it to final passage.
