

Mr. Stanis:

We have received your claim concerning ongoing issues and disturbances you have had at 2548A South 29th Street.

Our investigation reveals on November 28, 2012 the Milwaukee Police Department were dispatched to the alley way of your residence located at 2548A South 29th Street. Records indicate you and a neighbor (Richard Liberman) were creating a disturbance in the alley due to ongoing altercations over garbage carts and garbage picking in the rear of Mr. Liberman's residence. Once the police arrived, they investigated the incident and both you and Richard Liberman were issued Disorderly Conduct citations. The police did not observe any physical injuries to you at the scene on November 28, 2012 or when you reported to the 2nd District Police station on November 29, 2012.

The Milwaukee Police Department followed proper procedures in this matter, and all actions taken were appropriate. Since the police were not negligent in this matter, The City of Milwaukee would not be liable. Therefore, we are denying your claim.


