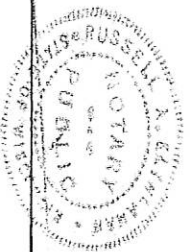

Notice is hereby given that an ordinance that was introduced at the May 24, 2016 meeting of the Milwaukee Common Council, the essence of which is as follows:

A substitute ordinance relating to the change in zoning of 6 parkways, corridors and trails located in the City of Milwaukee from various zoning districts to Parks, in the 1st, 3rd, 5th, 6th, 9th and 15th Aldermanic Districts.

Resolved, That the Mayor and Common Council of the City of Milwaukee, do ordain as follows:
Part 1. There is added to the Milwaukee Code of Ordinances a new section to read as follows:

The zoning map is amended to change the zoning for Part of the East Side Bike Trail, 1709 East Thomas Avenue, Tax Key No. 320-1526-000, from Two-Family Residential (RT4) to Parks (PK); and Part of the Former UP Railroad Corridor, 5443 North 13th Street, Tax Key No. 195-9917-000, 198 East Hampton Avenue, Tax Key No. 203-9997-100, and 5330 North Milwaukee River Parkway, Tax Key No. 196-9990-000, from Single-Family Residential (RS4) and Detailed Planned Development (DPD) to Parks (PK); and Part of Johnsons Park, 2001 West Garfield Avenue, Tax Key No. 350-0823-121, from Multi-Family Residential (RM4) to Parks (PK); and

Part of the Menomonee River Parkway, 12040 West Appleton Avenue, Tax Key No. 147-9981-110, from Single-Family Residential (RS2) to Parks (PK); and Part of the Milwaukee River Parkway, 5212 North Milwaukee River Parkway, Tax Key No. 196-0019-000; 2620 North Humboldt Boulevard, Tax Key No. 320-9979-000; 5258 North Milwaukee River Parkway, Tax Key No. 196-0031-000; 5349 North Milwaukee River Parkway, Tax Key No. 196-0004-000; 1201 East Center Street, Tax Key No. 320-9999-111; 5337 North Milwaukee River Parkway, Tax Key No. 196-0005-000; and 5262 North Milwaukee River Parkway, Tax Key No. 196-0032-000, from Single-Family Residential (RS4) and Two-Family Residential (RT4) to Parks (PK); and Part of the Little Menomonee River Parkway, 9722 West Allyn Street, Tax Key No. 034-1431-000, and 10401 West County Line Road, Tax Key No. 003-9998-000, from Multi-Family Residential (RM1) and Single-Family Residential (RS3) to Parks (PK).

Notice is hereby further given that the foregoing matter will be given a public hearing by the Committee on Zoning, Neighborhoods and Development in Room 301-B, City Hall, 200 East Wells Street, Milwaukee, Wisconsin, on Tuesday, July 19, 2016 at 9:00 A.M., pursuant to the provision of Sub-Section (7)(d) of Section 62.23 of the Revised Statutes of the State of Wisconsin.

PLEASE NOTE: a) Members of the Common Council, and members of its Standing Committees who are not members of this Committee, may attend this meeting to participate or

to gather information. Therefore, notice is given that this meeting may constitute a meeting of the Common Council or any of its Standing Committees, and must be noticed as such, although they will not take any formal action at this meeting.
