Dear Messrs. Metke and Mularski:

This is to notify you that on March 1, 2005 the City's Utilities and Licenses Committee voted to recommend to the City's Common Council that your renewal application for a Class "B" Tavern license for the premises located at 332 North Milwaukee Street in the City and County of Milwaukee, Wisconsin ("Metke's on Milwaukee") be approved with a twenty (20) day suspension. The Committee made such a recommendation based upon a police report.

On March 3, 2005 you were sent a true and correct copy of the findings of fact, conclusions of law and recommendations of the Utilities and Licenses Committee with respect to your renewal application for a Class "B" Tavern license in which the Committee recommended that your renewal application be approved with a twenty (20) day suspension. You were further notified that the Milwaukee Common Council would consider the matter at its meeting of March 16, 2005 commencing at 9:00 a.m. in the Common Council Chambers on the third floor of City Hall, 200 East Wells Street, Milwaukee, Wisconsin. You were advised of your right to file written objections or to appear personally or by counsel to address the Common Council. At that date, time and place you did appear and you were represented by counsel. You did not, however, file written objections to the recommendation of the Utilities and Licenses Committee.

Following consideration of the report of the Utilities and Licenses Committee, and your arguments, the Common Council adopted the recommendation of the Utilities and Licenses Committee by a vote of fifteen (15) Ayes to zero (0) Nays to renew the Class "B" Tavern license held by you for the premises at 332 North Milwaukee Street in the City and County of Milwaukee, Wisconsin with a twenty (20) day suspension.

Said suspension is to be in effect between the action of the Common Council on March 16, 2005 and midnight, April 4, 2005.
