(Assessable Reconstruction  
Paving Fund -- \$2,000;  
Nonassessable Reconstruction  
Paving Fund -- \$20,000. The total  
estimated cost for this project  
including the requested amount is  
\$40,000. This project is anticipated  
to be completed during the 2017  
construction season.
