Resolution celebrating the historical landmark dedication for the Stollenwerk/Correa House.

WHEREAS,

STOLLENWERK/CORREA HOUSE

was designated a historical landmark by the Bay View Historical Society during a special celebration held June 27, 2026; and

WHEREAS, *The Stollenwerk/Correa House, 2246 S. Aldrich St., is unique in that immigrants occupied the home for 114 of its 136 years, with the Stollenwerks living in the home from 1890 until 1953 (63 years) and the Correas living in the home from 1959 until 2010 (51 years), with both families being first generation immigrants; the Stollenwerks from Germany and the Correas from Mexico; and*

WHEREAS, *Both families had a tremendous impact on their respective ethnic communities, with the Stollenwerks being builders, architects, and carpenters who constructed numerous homes and buildings in Bay View who were also important merchants, and the Correas were leaders in the Latin community, with Raul helping establish live Latin music in the area, and his wife Maria working with Latino civil rights organizations; and*

WHEREAS, *The Stollenwerk/Correa House serves as a testament and celebration of Bay View's multi-ethnic immigrants and diversity that are still embedded in the fabric of the neighborhood today; now, therefore, be it*

RESOLVED, *That the Common Council of the City of Milwaukee herewith expresses its pride in the Stollenwerk/Correa House, and joins the Bay View Historical Society in recognizing the historical importance of this vibrant public space; and, be it*

FURTHER RESOLVED, *That a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution be presented to the Bay View Historical Society.*
