TITLE: A substitute ordinance relating to public passenger vehicle licensing, regulation and enforcement.

ITEM: Unfinished Business

COMMON COUNCIL

TEXT OF MOTION

I move to amend the Proposed Substitute by establishing that the license period for a public passenger vehicle permit shall be increased from one year to 2 years.

ANALYSIS OF AMENDMENT

Currently, each public passenger vehicle permit shall be valid for one year from the date of issuance. Upon amendment, a public passenger vehicle permit shall be valid for 2 years from the date of issuance, which is consistent with the license period for a public passenger vehicle driver's license. This amendment provides for a license and permit holder to have both the vehicle permit and driver's license to expire at the same time.

This amendment makes no revisions to the amount of any current license or permit fees.

TEXT OF AMENDMENT

Upon amendment, s. 81-101.5-1 of the code shall read:

81-101.5. Public Passenger Vehicle Permit.

1. Each permit shall be valid for 2 years from the date of issuance.
