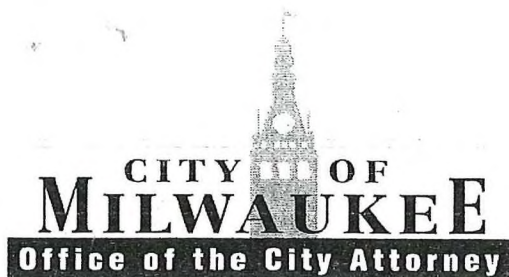

Dear Ms. Williams:

We are in receipt of your claim for damages that resulted when a branch from a City tree fell on your vehicle that was parked at 4585 North 23rd Street on April 6, 2022.

Our investigation reveals that the Forestry Department received a request for emergency service concerning a branch from a City tree that had fallen on a car on April 6, 2022 at 4585 North 23rd Street. A Forestry crew responded to the request on April 7, 2022 and found a branch that had fallen from a City tree laying at the curb. The Forestry employee noted that damage to your vehicle was consistent with the branch falling. The branch was alive with no evidence of decay at the point of failure. Based on picture evidence from Google street view, the branch appears to have been broken and hanging in the tree before falling on April 6, 2022.

In searching their records for the past six years, Forestry had one other request regarding a fallen branch from this tree on September 7, 2016.

There is no evidence that the City of Milwaukee is liable for damages in this case. As such, we are denying your claim.


