This office is in receipt of your claim in the amount of \$900.00, relating to damage caused by the Milwaukee Police on May 21, 2002 during the arrest of a suspected kidnapper at 2524 West Burleigh Street.

Our investigation reveals that the police action taken in this matter was necessary and appropriate. Since the police were not negligent, but rather were acting within the sphere of their responsibility, the City would not be liable. Accordingly, we are denying your claim.

If you wish to appeal this decision, you may do so by sending a letter within 21 days of the receipt of this letter to the Milwaukee City Clerk, 200 East Wells Street, Room 205, Milwaukee, Wisconsin 53202, requesting a hearing.
