There is a possibility that your application may be denied for  or more of the following reasons: The recommendation of the committee regarding the application shall be based on evidence presented at the hearing. Per MCO 85-4-4, unless otherwise specified in the code, probative evidence concerning non-renewal, suspension or revocation may include evidence of the following: failure of the applicant to meet municipal qualifications, pending charges against or the conviction of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the circumstances of the particular licensed or permitted activity, by the applicant or by any employee or other agent of the applicant. If the activities of the applicant involve a licensed premises, whether the premises tends to facilitate a public or private nuisance or has been the source of congregations of persons which have resulted in any of the following: disturbance of the peace; illegal drug activity; public drunkenness; drinking in public; harassment of passers-by; gambling; prostitution; sale of stolen goods; public urination; theft; assaults; battery; acts of vandalism including graffiti, excessive littering, loitering, illegal parking, loud noise at times when the licensed premise is open for business; traffic violations; curfew violations; lewd conduct; display of materials harmful to minors, pursuant to s. 106-9.6; or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety and welfare, or failure to comply with the approved plan of operation. It is the intention of the Common Council to suspend or non-renew the licenses if objectors provide testimony related to the factors enumerated in MCO 85-4-4 that the Common Council finds to be true by a preponderance of the evidence and/or police reports are found to be true by a preponderance of the evidence. The police reports and other attached documents relating to objections to the license are a part of this notice and expressly incorporated in this notice. The licensee should be prepared to address these matters at the hearing.

**Notice for applicants with
warrants or unpaid fines:**

Proof of warrant satisfaction or payment of fines must be submitted at the hearing on the above date and time. Failure to comply with this requirement may result in a delay of the granting/denial of your application.

Failure to appear at this meeting may result in the denial of your license. Individual applicants must appear only in person or by an attorney. Corporate or Limited Liability applicants must appear only by the agent designated on the application or by an attorney. Partnership applicants must appear by a partner listed on the application or by an attorney. If you wish to do so and at your own expense, you may be accompanied by an attorney of your choosing to represent you at this hearing.

You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify. You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. If you have difficulty with the English language, you should bring an interpreter with you, at your expense, so that you can answer questions and participate in your hearing.

You may examine the application file at this office during regular business hours prior to the hearing date. Inquiries regarding this matter may be directed to the person whose signature appears below.

To Whom It May Concern:

I am writing to file a formal complaint against Fremo's Bar & Grill, located at 6449 W. Fond du Lac Avenue, Milwaukee, WI 53218, regarding a serious and deeply troubling incident that occurred on April 4, 2026. This incident resulted in the death of _____, who was shot multiple times directly outside the establishment and died on the scene. This tragedy raises grave concerns about the bar's responsibility for the safety of its patrons and the surrounding community.

On April 4, 2026, a patron identified as _____ was permitted to exit Fremo's Bar. Shortly thereafter, staff and/or security at the establishment allowed another individual, identified as _____ to leave the bar immediately after _____. Once outside, _____ proceeded to shoot _____ multiple times in front of the establishment. _____ died on the scene as a result of those gunshot wounds.

It is my belief that the staff and/or security personnel at Fremo's Bar were, or reasonably should have been, aware of a potential conflict between these two individuals prior to allowing both to exit in close succession. By failing to intervene, delay one party's departure, contact law enforcement, or take any other reasonable precautionary measure, the establishment failed in its duty of care to its patrons and to the public at large.

Licensed establishments in the City of Milwaukee are expected to uphold standards that protect the health, safety, and welfare of the community. The death of _____ is a devastating consequence of what appears to be a failure to meet those standards. I respectfully request that the License Division conduct a thorough investigation into this matter, review any available surveillance footage from the establishment, and consider whether Fremo's Bar & Grill's liquor license and operating

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license should be subject to review, suspension, or revocation pending the outcome of that investigation.

I am available to provide any additional information that may assist your office in this investigation. I can be reached at the contact information listed above. I urge your office to treat this matter with the seriousness it deserves and to take all appropriate action to prevent similar incidents from occurring in the future.

To Whom It May Concern,

I write this letter with a heart that is shattered and a mind searching for answers. I feel a deep sense of responsibility to speak on behalf of someone who can no longer speak for himself...my friend,

life was taken in a senseless and preventable act of violence outside of Fremo's Bar. What makes this tragedy even more painful to process is not only the loss itself, but the circumstances that led up to it. My friend was involved in a physical altercation inside the bar, and instead of the situation being de-escalated with care, awareness, and proper safety protocol, both individuals involved were put outside at the same time.

In that moment when safety should have been the priority was placed directly in harm's way.

The individual he had just been in conflict with, was allowed to exit simultaneously. Within moments, that same individual came up behind and shot him in cold blood. My friend was murdered right there outside the establishment that should have taken reasonable steps to protect the safety of its patrons.

And I cannot help but ask the questions that now echo in my mind every single day:

Why would trained security allow two individuals who were just involved in a physical altercation to be released together at the same time? Where was the judgment? Was there any real training? Where was the responsibility to prevent escalation rather than enable? And should that individual also be charged with the senseless death of my friend Trel.

And even more troubling...how did this individual gain access to a firearm so quickly? If proper security procedures were followed, how was a weapon either allowed inside or so easily retrieved immediately after exiting?

These are not just questions. These are the gaps where accountability should live.

As I sit with this grief, what deepens the pain even further is the complete absence of compassion and responsibility from the establishment. There has been no meaningful

I respectfully, but urgently, request that the City of Milwaukee thoroughly investigate the practices, training, and safety protocols of Fremo's Bar. And with that being said, I strongly urge you to reconsider the renewal of this establishment's license.

Because when safety is mishandled, when preventable harm is not prevented, and when accountability is absent, there must be consequences!!!

No one should have to live with the question of "what if this had been handled differently?" I ask you to hold that question in mind. And, as you do, I ask you to make a decision that prioritizes life, safety, and responsibility over business as usual.

I owned property in The City of Milwaukee, I have paid taxes to The City of Milwaukee, I have worked for the City of Milwaukee, I have even retired from the City of Milwaukee. I am writing as a devastated broken-hearted _____ f another black male that has died in The City of Milwaukee due to gun violence!

On Saturday, April 4th, 2026, _____ and his cousin entered Fremos. Shortly after, he got into a physical altercation with another patron, _____ inside Fremos bathroom. Afterwards, _____ was directed out the side door. Somehow _____ was not far behind him carrying a gun. He shot and killed _____ Unfortunately, he was declared dead on Sunday, April 5th, 2026, Easter Sunday. The Easter Holiday will never be the same joyous occasion with my _____ being absent in body. I am devastated! I still want to believe it's not true! I never imagined that I would be dealing with this type of loss. I wouldn't want any _____ deal with this pain! This has left a permanent void in my life as well as his children's lives, his grandchildren's lives, and the lives of his siblings and family and friends alike.

It gives me so much sadness to write this letter. I am not sure how or why the physical altercation happened inside of the bathroom inside Fremos that night. I am only sure by the facts the Milwaukee Police Department and its Detectives presented to _____ regarding the tragic death of _____. Yes, the shooting took place after the bathroom incident and after _____ and _____ were escorted out the door by the security there. Only thing was they were not off the premises. _____ the shooter, approached _____ within seconds with a handgun to his side! He shot _____ several times causing his death right outside of Fremos doors.

I am sure I am not the only _____ that has had such a tragedy occur because of the negligence of an entertainment venue or its' security personnel in The City of Milwaukee. I believe this tragedy could have been prevented if _____ would not have been let out of the premises so soon after _____. I believe if the bar would have taken more measures to detain either of them for several more minutes to deescalate the situation; I believe I would not have had to bury _____ because of another black male's

anger! This reflects a serious failure in judgment, safety procedures, and responsibility on the part of the establishment. Proper de-escalation and separation measures should have taken place. Instead, the actions of the hired security or other personnel there created an opportunity for violence to take place. Sadly, had to pay with his life.

The violence that occurred at this location raises significant concern to me, my family, my neighbors, and the public alike, whether this business is operating in a way that promotes positivity and protection to its patrons which come from the public of The City of Milwaukee.

I am demanding that accountability takes place regarding this venue, Fremos Bar, located at 6449 W Fond Du Lac Avenue, Milwaukee, WI 53218, which is nestled in the heart of The City of Milwaukee. I request The City Council to investigate Fremos and the effectiveness of its operating a secure location where patrons may oblige their business and not have to lose their lives at the hands of violence associated with this establishment.

To the Members of the Milwaukee Common Council Licenses Committee,

I am writing in strong opposition to the renewal of the liquor license for Fremos located on Fond du Lac Avenue in Milwaukee. My family recently suffered a devastating tragedy when my 1
was shot and killed following an incident connected to this establishment on Easter morning of 2026.

No family should ever have to endure the pain of losing a loved one in such a violent and senseless manner. Unfortunately, this tragedy appears to be part of a larger and deeply concerning pattern connected to this location and surrounding area. Businesses that profit from serving alcohol also carry a responsibility to maintain proper security measures and provide a reasonably safe environment for patrons and the surrounding community.

At the very least, Fremos appears guilty of failing to adequately search patrons entering the establishment. either possessed a firearm inside the establishment or obtained one from someone already inside. Either possibility reflects a catastrophic security failure. This means security procedures were inadequate, searches were not properly conducted, or individuals associated with the establishment allowed dangerous conditions to exist inside the business.

The citizens of Milwaukee deserve businesses that operate responsibly and prioritize safety over profit. Repeated violence associated with establishments serving alcohol should not simply be accepted as normal operating conditions. When a location becomes connected to serious violence, shootings, and homicide, the Common Council has both the authority and obligation to carefully examine whether that establishment should continue operating under its current license.

This issue extends beyond one family. The surrounding neighborhood and broader Milwaukee community deserve accountability, responsible security practices, and meaningful action to reduce violence. Allowing businesses with repeated violent incidents to continue operating without significant consequences sends the wrong message to both operators and residents.

I respectfully urge the Licenses Committee to deny the renewal of Fremos' liquor license or, at minimum, require substantial security reforms, including:

- Enhanced professional security staffing
- Mandatory weapon screening procedures
- Improved surveillance systems
- Increased accountability measures for ownership and management
- Cooperation with law enforcement and neighborhood safety initiatives

To Whom It May Concern,

I am submitting this formal complaint with profound grief and urgency regarding the tragic and preventable death of my cousin,

On the night of this incident, life was taken inside Fremos by —an individual who was allowed to enter the establishment with a firearm. This act was witnessed by multiple individuals, captured on surveillance footage, and resulted in an arrest.

This was not an unforeseeable death. It was a failure! To him, his children, grandchildren, and relating family.

Fremos had a clear responsibility to maintain a safe environment for its patrons. Allowing an armed individual to enter and remain inside the premises represents a severe breakdown in basic security procedures and a breach of duty of care. That failure directly contributed to the loss of my cousin's life.

wasn't just another man. He was loved by so many people. I cannot and will not stand by and do nothing. So I wrote this letter to whomever's eyes it falls upon. Do Something!!

Our family is now left with unimaginable grief, along with serious and necessary questions:

What security measures were in place at the time of the incident?

How did those measures fail to detect or prevent a firearm from entering?

Were staff properly trained and actively enforcing safety protocols?

Were there prior incidents or violations that indicated ongoing risks to public safety?

This tragedy raises significant concerns about whether this establishment is capable of safely operating within the community.

We respectfully demand a full, thorough, and transparent investigation into Fremos' security practices, staff conduct, and compliance with all applicable licensing and safety regulations. If negligence or violations are identified, we strongly urge the License Division and all appropriate authorities to take immediate and decisive action, including suspension or permanent revocation of this establishment's license.

No business should be permitted to continue operations if it cannot uphold the most basic responsibility of protecting the lives of its patrons. There have been numerous disturbances concerning this establishment. To allow them to stay operational is a slap in the face for us as a family. I implore you. This business must go and should not be allowed to reopen indefinitely.

This is about justice for . It's about accountability. And it is about preventing another family from experiencing a loss that could have been avoided.

We expect this matter to be treated with the seriousness it deserves and for appropriate action to follow.

To Whom It May Concern,

My name is _____ and I am the older cousin of _____. I am writing on behalf of our family, along with other concerned individuals, to formally express our deep concern and request a full investigation into the tragic incident that occurred on April 4, 2026, at Fremo's Bar, located at 6449 W Fond du Lac Avenue, Milwaukee, WI 53218.

We are seeking accountability and answers regarding the circumstances that led to death.

Our concerns are as follows:

First, we question why two individuals who had just been involved in an altercation inside the establishment were removed from the bar at the same time. It is our understanding that both _____ and the individual identified as _____ were escorted out together, which appears to have created an unsafe situation and directly contributed to the events that followed.

Second, we are deeply troubled by how the defendant was able to possess a firearm inside the bar. We want to understand how a weapon was brought into the establishment and how the situation was handled by staff and security, if any were present.

Third, we question how the defendant was able to approach _____ from behind and fatally shoot him without intervention. We are asking what safety measures were in place and why no action was taken to prevent this escalation.

As a family, we are devastated. _____ death has had a profound impact on all of us. He was a father, and his children will now grow up without him. The pain and loss we are experiencing cannot be put into words.

We are also deeply concerned that no one has reached out to our family to provide information, support, or clarity regarding what happened. We deserve answers, transparency, and accountability.

Due to the seriousness of these concerns, we respectfully request that the License Division conduct a thorough investigation into Fremo's Bar for potential negligence and failure to provide a safe environment for its patrons. We also ask that appropriate action be taken, up to and including the possible suspension or revocation of the establishment's license, if violations are found.

I, the undersigned, respectfully submit this formal complaint to express our profound concern and grief regarding the tragic and preventable loss of life connected to the establishment known as Fremos, located at 6449 W Fond du Lac Avenue, Milwaukee, WI 53218.

It is our understanding that an altercation originated inside the premises and that both individuals involved—
—y and the other individual, identified as —were removed from the establishment at the same time. This action raises serious concerns regarding the judgment and duty of care exercised by staff. We ask: why were both men expelled simultaneously, despite the evident conflict between them? Such a decision appears to have created a foreseeable and dangerous situation, rather than de-escalating it.

Equally troubling is the allegation that, was able to enter the establishment while in possession of a firearm. We seek clarity as to how this was permitted. Was he allowed entry without proper screening because he was considered a "regular"? If so, this points to a deeply concerning lapse in security protocols and enforcement. The failure to prevent weapons from entering the premises represents a significant breach of responsibility owed to patrons.

As a result of these apparent failures, lost his life. This loss extends far beyond the incident itself. was a devoted father, a cherished grandfather, and a beloved son. His children must now navigate life without their father's presence and guidance. His grandchildren are left without the opportunity to grow up knowing their grandfather. A mother now carries the immeasurable grief of losing her son. This is not only a tragedy—it is a lasting injustice to an entire family.

We assert that the actions and omissions of the establishment may constitute negligence. The circumstances suggest a failure to uphold reasonable safety measures, proper conflict management, and adequate security practices that could have prevented this devastating outcome.

We respectfully request a thorough and transparent investigation into this matter, including but not limited to:

- The establishment's security policies and procedures
- Staff training and response protocols during altercations
- Entry screening practices and enforcement
- The sequence of events and decision-making on the night in question

In addition, we formally request that the License Division review the operating license of this establishment and consider appropriate disciplinary action. Such actions may include suspension or revocation of the establishment's license, as well as the imposition of any penalties deemed necessary based on the findings of the investigation. Given the severity of this incident and the potential failures in duty of care, we believe a comprehensive review of the establishment's ability to safely operate is both warranted and necessary.

We further urge the License Division to take any and all appropriate action necessary to ensure accountability and to prevent such a tragedy from occurring again.

This complaint is submitted not only in pursuit of answers, but in the hope that meaningful change will result—so that no other family in our community must endure such an irreplaceable loss.

Interview with Shayla Peters

I spoke with Shayla R Peters (B/F, 04-14-1999) who stated she was at Fremos Bar located at (6449 W Fond Du Lac Ave) with her aunt Michell L Carver (B/F, 07-24-1980). She stated she got there at about 4:30pm and her aunt was already there. Peters stated she met up with her aunt to watch the football game. While inside the bar she was talking to someone and didn't realize that her friend who she only know as "William" was standing behind her. She stated she didn't see him for over a week due to being sick but communicated everyday through phone. Peters stated William is a friend whom she had intimate relationships with. She stated she only knew him for 4 months. Peters stated they have no children in common and has never lived together. She stated she was surprised to see him at the bar. Peters showed me a picture of him with her from her phone. She stated when her aunt went outside the bar she followed behind her. Peters stated when William came back he pointed a gun at her and her aunt. Peters stated she was more focused on the gun than anything at the time. Peters described the gun as a black Taurus gun. She stated they were scared and feared for their safety and ran inside the bar to notify the security and staff. At this time no one called the police. She stated the bar has surveillance cameras that captured the incident. Peters stated after they ran inside William went to his vehicle and circled the bar at least ten times. She described the vehicle as a black Lincoln truck. Peters stated that after the incident William called and text her several times. She stated she did not answer the phone or reply to his text. Peters showed me when Williams called and text her. He told her in the text message "I'm outside your house". She stated she contacted his wife Stacey to tell her what happened and get his legal government name. Peters had no other information to provide.

Interview of Michell L Carver

I spoke with Michell L Carver (B/F, 07-24-1980) who stated she was at Fremos Bar watching the game. She stated she saw "William" a guy her niece mess with. She stated she noticed him standing behind her niece. So she asked him why he was at the bar when her niece told him to leave and didn't want to be bothered by him. Carver stated he then stated "That's alright don't worry about it I got yall watch this". Carver stated she went outside after him because she knew he was going to arm himself with a gun and wanted to deter him from bringing the gun inside the bar. She stated she told him don't do that. Carver stated William came back and pointed the gun at her and her niece saying "I'll kill both of yall". Carver stated they went in the bar to tell security and when security came out William was already in his vehicle. Carver described William as a black male, 6'2", thin build, long dark brown dreads, wearing a gray stone washed Green Bay Packer hoodie with blue jeans. She described the gun as a black 9mm black Taurus medium size. Carver stated she will protect herself because she is a conceal carry permit holder.

Peters and Carver was unable to provide a legal name for Williams. They were advised to contact when they find out.

A call was placed for an officer to check for the video (P25-1207-1210). Squad 7468 Police Officer Taylor Motiff responded and spoke with the worker at the bar. He was advised to contact the managers during
