There is a possibility that your application may be denied for one or more of the following reasons: The recommendation of the committee regarding the application shall be based on evidence presented at the hearing. Per MCO 85-4-4, unless otherwise specified in the code, probative evidence concerning non-renewal, suspension or revocation may include evidence of the following: failure of the applicant to meet municipal qualifications, pending charges against or the conviction of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the circumstances of the particular licensed or permitted activity, by the applicant or by any employee or other agent of the applicant. If the activities of the applicant involve a licensed premises, whether the premises tends to facilitate a public or private nuisance or has been the source of congregations of persons which have resulted in any of the following: disturbance of the peace; illegal drug activity; public drunkenness; drinking in public; harassment of passers-by; gambling; prostitution; sale of stolen goods; public urination; theft; assaults; battery; acts of vandalism including graffiti, excessive littering, loitering, illegal parking, loud noise at times when the licensed premise is open for business; traffic violations; curfew violations; lewd conduct; display of materials harmful to minors, pursuant to s. 106-9.6; or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety and welfare, or failure to comply with the approved plan of operation. See attached police report or correspondence.

Notice for applicants with warrants or unpaid fines:

Proof of warrant satisfaction or payment of fines must be submitted at the hearing on the above date and time. Failure to comply with this requirement may result in a delay of the granting/denial of your application.

Failure to appear at this meeting may result in the denial of your license. Individual applicants must appear only in person or by an attorney. Corporate or Limited Liability applicants must appear only by the agent designated on the application or by an attorney. Partnership applicants must appear by a partner listed on the application or by an attorney. If you wish to do so and at your own expense, you may be accompanied by an attorney of your choosing to represent you at this hearing.

You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify. You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. If you have difficulty with the English language, you should bring an interpreter with you, at your expense, so that you can answer questions and participate in your hearing.

You may examine the application file at this office during regular business hours prior to the hearing date. Inquiries regarding this matter may be directed to the person whose signature appears below.

This report is written by Police Officer Corstan D. COURT, assigned to the License Investigation Unit, Days.

The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:

1. On 02/20/2012, the applicant was convicted of Operating While Intoxicated (1st) in Milwaukee County. Her license was revoked for 7 months.

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2. On 10/22/12 at 1:41 am, Milwaukee police were dispatched to 35th and Greenfield for a Trouble With Subject complaint in front of Hang Overz Sports Bar. Upon arrival, police spoke with the bartender identified as Nicole Hochstein. Hochstein stated there were no disturbances in or outside the bar. Call was advised.
3. On 10/25/12 at 1:21 am, Milwaukee police were dispatched to 31st and Greenfield for a Shots Fired complaint. Police entered the Hang Overz bar and spoke with the bartender Nicole Hochstein. Hochstein stated that she had only about 6 customers and that one female patron was with 2 males patrons when the female made a phone call for a ride. Hochstein stated the females ride arrived and that the female left and that the two males that were with the female went outside and were talking to the female. Hochstein stated she thought she heard an argument and then gunshots. Hochstein stated she never left the tavern and had no descriptions of the individuals involved. Police notified the agent, Tina Minto about the incident. Also discussed were some safety ideas such as checking for weapons at the door, on-site security and cameras for the interior and exterior of the bar. Police conducted a canvass of the area and located four .380 caliber casings that were

found outside the tavern. A citizen provided police video that captured people running from the location after the incident. That video was placed on police inventory.

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4. On 03/05/2014 Milwaukee police responded to an Entry complaint at 3121 West Greenfield Avenue (Hangoverz). The applicant told officers that someone had used a key to enter the business between 2:00am and 6:00am and that \$100.00 was missing from the cash register. Milwaukee police incident report #140640108 filed.

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5. On 10/11/2014 Milwaukee police responded to a fight at 3121 West Greenfield Avenue (Hangoverz bar). Investigation revealed the victim entered the business and was confronted by her ex-boyfriend, who punched her in the back of the head. During this encounter, officers observed several violations of the business's class B tavern license. Milwaukee police incident report #142840009 filed.

6. On 11/25/2014 Milwaukee police, along with Agent Georgeann King from the Wisconsin Department of Revenue, conducted a licensed premise check at 3121 West Greenfield Avenue (Hanoverz). During this check, it was discovered that four bottles of liquor and several cans of beer were purchased at a retail location and were subsequently confiscated by Agent King.

7. On 12/05/2014 Milwaukee police conducted a licensed premise check at 3121 West Greenfield Avenue (Hangoverz). No violations were observed.

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8. On 12/24/2015 Milwaukee police responded to an attempt entry complaint at 3121 West Greenfield Avenue (Hang Overz Sports Bar). Investigation revealed someone attempted to enter the business by removing a screen that leads to the women's bathroom and then pried on the window frame. Milwaukee police incident report #153580140 filed.

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9. On 03/04/2017 at 3:56am officers responded to Hangoverz, 3121 W. Greenfield Av, for a complaint of patrons inside after hours. When the officers entered the tavern they observed 7 patrons still in the business. The bartender, Christopher GALLEGOS, stated the subjects refused to leave. GALLEGOS and the patrons were cited for being in the tavern after hours. GALLEGOS stated the owner, MINTO, was in the Dominican Republic.

10. On 05/11/2017 officers investigated a noise nuisance complaint at Hangovez, 3121 W. Greenfield Av. The officer was unable to hear the music except when the door was open. He spoke with the bartender who stated he would turn the music down when the door was open.

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11. On 03/19/18 at 11:40 pm, Milwaukee Police were dispatch to 3121 W. Greenfield Avenue (Hangoverz Tavern) for a battery complaint. Investigation revealed that an intoxicated subject was inside the tavern verbally harassing a female inside the establishment and when the intoxicated person approached the female he was harassing, she hit him softly

with a pool que. The intoxicated subject was asked to leave and no citations were issued. No Tavern violations were observed.

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12. On 05/21/2019 at 11:48pm officers were dispatched to Hangoverz, 3121 W. Greenfield Av, for a fight. When the officers arrived they observed a group of people outside. They were advised those subjects were involved and may be armed. The officers stopped the subjects, then spoke with the bartender. The bartender stated there was a group inside arguing so she kicked them out before they could fight. She never saw any weapons or any fighting. The subjects were released with no action.

The hearing before the Licenses Committee will take place on 11/29/2022 at 9:10 AM in Room 301-B, Third Floor, City Hall. This is a public hearing. Those wishing to view the proceeding are able to do so via the City Channel – Channel 25 on Spectrum Cable – or on the Internet at <http://city.milwaukee.gov/citychannel>. Those wishing to provide oral testimony via phone or internet are asked to contact the staff assistant, Yadira Melendez at (414) 286-2775 or stasst5@milwaukee.gov for necessary information. Please make such requests no later than one business day prior to the start of the meeting. You are not required to attend the hearing, but please see the information below if you would like to provide testimony. Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing.

Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)
6. You may then provide testimony.
 - a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
 - b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
 - c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
 - d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.
Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.
