If the activities of the applicant involve a licensed premises, whether the premises tends to facilitate a public or private nuisance or has been the source of congregations of persons which have resulted in any of the following: disturbance of the peace; illegal drug activity; public drunkenness; drinking in public; harassment of passers-by; gambling; prostitution; sale of stolen goods; public urination; theft; assaults; battery; acts of vandalism including graffiti, excessive littering, loitering, illegal parking, loud noise at times when the licensed premise is open for business; traffic violations; curfew violations; lewd conduct; display of materials harmful to minors, pursuant to s. 106-9.6; or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety and welfare, or failure to comply with the approved plan of operation. It is the intention of the Common Council to suspend or non-renew the licenses if objectors provide testimony related to the factors enumerated in MCO 85-4-4 that the Common Council finds to be true by a preponderance of the evidence and/or police reports are found to be true by a preponderance of the evidence. The police reports and other attached documents relating to objections to the license are a part of this notice and expressly incorporated in this notice. The licensee should be prepared to address these matters at the hearing.

This report is written by *Sgt. Brian LaROQUE*, assigned to *District Six, Early Shift, as Squad 6211*.

On Saturday, July 15, 2023, at 22:45hrs, I conducted a License Premise Check (Tavern Check) at the Blind Tiger AKA Makk'n'Cheese/Blind Tiger, located at 2242 S Kinnickinnic Av.

Squad 6231 (Officers Harold ALMAS, and Officer Eric LAUX), responded to the location to assist me with the License Premise Check. During this check I searched the area of the business listed on the license, and areas where staff showed me where they stored supplies or products for sale.

It should be noted that I am not equipped with a Body Worn Camera (BWC) but Officer ALMAS and Officer LAUX both were wearing their BWCs and that they were activated during the investigation. As I approached the tavern, I noticed that the open sign was illuminated, and I noted a sandwich board sign in the front of the building advertising the prices of their drinks. Upon entering the establishment, I noted two entertainment machines as well as a pull tab machine across from the entrance.

I walked toward the back of the establishment and observed a female seated at the bar with one female employee behind the bar. I identified myself to the employee, later identified as Doratea (NMN) CARINI (W/F, 12/7/79), and informed her that I was there to conduct a tavern check. I asked CARINI if she had her license (referring to her bartender's license) and she stated that she did not have one. I asked her where the business licenses are posted, and she stated that she did not know.

CARINI stated that she would call her manager, later identified as Juan F RODRIGUEZ (W/M, 8/4/91), to have him come to the location. I continued my check of the area and observed that all of the open liquor bottles were free from contaminants. I did note that there were a few food items and other wine and liquor in a walk-in fridge just past the bar and that the fridge was broken. CARINI stated that the fridge broke a few weeks ago and all of the items inside of it had yet to be disposed of. We walked through the kitchen and CARINI stated that the kitchen had been closed for several months at this point and that she believed the business was in the process of being sold.

I observed a Hookah on the bar and asked CARINI where they kept the Hookah products. CARINI escorted me to the stairway in the back hallway where I observed a folding table on the stairs. I observed on the table a hot plate, several Hookahs, as well as Hookah tobacco.

After coming back to the bar, I was advising CARINI that she would have to lock up because she stated she did not have a Bartenders license. While speaking with CARINI, RODRIGUEZ entered the tavern. I then spoke with RODRIGUEZ who identified himself as the manager for the business. I asked RODRIGUEZ for the licenses, and he was unable to produce them. RODRIGUEZ stated that he was the manager for the business but that he only handled the currency, and that the owner handled the hiring/firing of employees and ordering the products for the business. I asked RODRIGUEZ if he had his Class D Bartenders License or Manager's License and he stated that it was not on him. During this time, he made a remark that he did not believe it was expired. I asked RODRIGUEZ if he had the receipts for the liquor in the building and he provided me a stack of invoices. The most recent invoice was dated 2/15/23 and on the invoice was 17 bottles of liquor and 3 or 4 cases of another products. I asked RODRIGUEZ if he had any other invoices and he stated, "probably, but the owner is not very organized".

I noted that the business had a total of 16 security cameras with 1 of them not in operation. I observed a total of 12 working cameras inside, and 2 working cameras outside. It is unknown where the 1 non-working camera is located. I noted that the business does not have security at the location, nor did I observe other security means (ie. Metal detectors, wands, I.D. scanners, etc.).

After leaving the tavern I checked LIRA and found the following licenses for the business.

Class B Tavern - 210513-20 Expires 10/10/2023

Public Entertainment Premise - 8420-361 Expires 10/10/2023 / Allowed DJ and Jukebox

Food Dealer License - 17934-262 Expires 10/10/2023

The agent for the above licenses was identified as, Marcos A RAMOS-GARCIA (W/M, 3/1/85).

I checked for a Bartenders License for CARINI with negative results.

I then checked for a License for RODRIGUEZ and found a Class D Bartenders License that expired on 12/31/2017.

Please make such requests no later than one business day prior to the start of the meeting. You are not required to attend the hearing, but please see the information below if you would like to provide testimony. Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing.

Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)
6. You may then provide testimony.
 - a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
 - b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
 - c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
 - d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.
Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.
