WHEREAS, *Christ Church has proudly stood as “A House of Worship for All People” for 130 years guided by the principle of “Unity of Spirit in the bond of peace”, and continues to thrive as a vibrant, welcoming community of faith; and*

WHEREAS, *Christ Church remains committed to worship, fellowship, and community outreach, supporting nearby schools, homeless ministries, and numerous local non-profit organizations throughout the greater Milwaukee area; and*

WHEREAS, *Christ Church reflects the rich history of the Bay View community and represents the evolving landscape of Christianity in the 21st century by welcoming all people as a part of body of Christ; now, therefore, be it*

RESOLVED, *That the Common Council of the City of Milwaukee herewith recognizes Christ Church on the occasion of its 130th anniversary, and commends the organization for all it has done to improve the surrounding community; and, be it*
