Norquist (1997) and for the Milwaukee City Clerk's office (1998) during the summers; and

WHEREAS, José obtained a B.A. in political science from Cardinal Stritch in May 1999 and soon became MICAH's executive director and led the organization to create the Good Jobs and Livable Neighborhoods Coalition, consisting of labor and community organizations to ensure the Park East Land Corridor development would benefit the entire city, and during his tenure the 12th District has experienced major growth and development in terms of new businesses, new retail and housing, and enhancements of public spaces; and

WHEREAS, Alderman Pérez is vice chair of the Zoning, Neighborhoods and Development Committee and serves on several boards, including the Milwaukee Metropolitan Sewerage District, NLC Hispanic Elected Local Officials, Milwaukee Continuum of Care and Harbor District Milwaukee; and

WHEREAS, The UMOS Hispanic Awards honor the contributions of Wisconsin Hispanics to their communities, and Alderman José G. Pérez is an outstanding example of an individual making a positive impact on the lives of others; now, therefore, be it
