File #021588 is a resolution authorizing the issuance of short-term promissory notes for the purpose of financing the operating budget on an interim basis.

Background and Discussion

- This resolution authorizes the City of Milwaukee to issue short—term promissory notes to finance the City's operating budget until the City receives shared revenue payments from the State of Wisconsin.
- 2. The City of Milwaukee annually issues short-term promissory notes in anticipation of receiving shared revenue payments from the State of Wisconsin.
- 3. The City of Milwaukee anticipates receiving approximately \$250 million in shared revenue payments in 2003 from the State of Wisconsin.
- 4. The City of Milwaukee expects to receive \$45,478,150 in July and \$204,442,850 in November.
- 5. Shared revenue from the State of Wisconsin will provide approximately 45% of the City's General Fund operating revenue for 2003.
- 6. The maximum amount of the sale of the promissory notes will total no more than \$125,000,000.

Fiscal Impact

The Comptroller's Office estimates 2003 expenditures of \$1.3 million for debt service and \$150,000 for issuance costs and earn \$450,000 in General Fund revenue from the interest earned on the proceeds.
