There is a possibility that your application may be denied for one or more of the following reasons: The recommendation of the committee regarding the application shall be based on evidence presented at the hearing. Per MCO 85-4-4, unless otherwise specified in the code, probative evidence concerning non-renewal, suspension or revocation may include evidence of the following: failure of the applicant to meet municipal qualifications, pending charges against or the conviction of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the circumstances of the particular licensed or permitted activity, by the applicant or by any employee or other agent of the applicant. If the activities of the applicant involve a licensed premises, whether the premises tends to facilitate a public or private nuisance or has been the source of congregations of persons which have resulted in any of the following: disturbance of the peace; illegal drug activity; public drunkenness; drinking in public; harassment of passers-by; gambling; prostitution; sale of stolen goods; public urination; theft; assaults; battery; acts of vandalism including graffiti, excessive littering, loitering, illegal parking, loud noise at times when the licensed premise is open for business; traffic violations; curfew violations; lewd conduct; display of materials harmful to minors, pursuant to s. 106-9.6; or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety and welfare, or failure to comply with the approved plan of operation. Notice for applicants with warrants or unpaid fines:

Proof of warrant satisfaction or payment of fines must be submitted at the hearing on the above date and time. Failure to comply with this requirement may result in a delay of the granting/denial of your application.

Failure to appear at this meeting may result in the denial of your license. Individual applicants must appear only in person or by an attorney. Corporate or Limited Liability applicants must appear only by the agent designated on the application or by an attorney. Partnership applicants must appear by a partner listed on the application or by an attorney. If you wish to do so and at your own expense, you may be accompanied by an attorney of your choosing to represent you at this hearing.

You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify. You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. If you have difficulty with the English language, you should bring an interpreter with you, at your expense, so that you can answer questions and participate in your hearing.

You may examine the application file at this office during regular business hours prior to the hearing date. Inquiries regarding this matter may be directed to the person whose signature appears below.

If you wish, you may provide testimony at the hearing regarding the request; see below for further information. You are not required to attend the hearing. Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing. Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)
6. You may then provide testimony.
 - a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
 - b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
 - c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
 - d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.
Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.

This report is written by Police Officer Corstan D. COURT, assigned to the License Investigation Unit, Days.

The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:

1. On 08/11/18 at 9:25am, a 17 year old working in conjunction with the Milwaukee Police Department and WI WINS Tobacco initiative was able to purchase a 2 pack of Duchmaster Honey Fusion Gold Cigars at 2500 N. Booth Street, The sales clerk admitted to selling the item and the station was mailed a MARTS enrollment packet.
2. On 03/20/19 at 5:53pm, Milwaukee Police conducted a license premise check at the address of 2500 N. Booth Street (Midget Foods). Upon arrival, officer's interviewed the clerk who stated the license agent had just left the establishment and would be back soon. While waiting for the agent, officer's attempted, but could not find, any license's associated with the business and after checking the on-line LIRA system, officers found that they have a temporary food license which is valid until 07/23/19. The agent arrived back at the store and informed officers that he had paid the fees for the licenses and he could still operate the business. He also said that when he paid his renewal fees, the people at the office said he was "good to go." He then contacted the Alderwoman's office to get a provisional license but never heard anything back from the Alderwoman. The agent was told by officers that he needs to contact those responsible for issuing the license and get a copy of the licenses or see if he needs to remain closed until the committee and the common council approves his licenses.

This report is written by PO David LETTEER, assigned to the District 5 Tavern Squad (5468) with PO Russell MACRAE.

On 03/20/2019 at 5:53 p.m., we conducted a licence premise check of Midget Foods, located at 2500 N. Booth St., which is licensed premise in the city of Milwaukee.

Upon entry to the business, a corner store, we were met by Tariq M. AL-ABDULLAH (A/M 01-24-68), who stated the boss, Nizar ALKHATIB, the licensed agent, had just left and that he was on his way back. AL-ABDULLAH stated he has worked at the store in the past and knows how to handle the cash register. While there we asked AL-ABDULLAH if we could see the licenses that were issued by the city of Milwaukee, in regards to running the business. AL-ABDULLAH could not locate any licensees, nor could PO MACRAE. I checked the online licensing system and found that the business has a Temp Food Dealer license (3948), which is valid until 07/23/2019.

While checking the online system, it was found that the business has applications for AMALT (289818), which is scheduled for committee, Provisional Renewal (289821) pending aldermanic approval, ALIQR (289817) Issuance pending requirements met, Cigarette (289819) which is ready to be issued and Food Dealer (289820) which is also ready to be issued. The application dates for all of these were 03/04/19.

The agent of the business, ALKHATIB arrived back to the store and informed us that he was under the belief that he could still be operating, due to paying the fees for his licenses. He stated he did not get a copy of them, but paid for them. He stated he contacted Alderwoman Coggs office in order to get a provisional license, but never heard anything back from her office.

He stated that when he put down his money for his license renewal, that he was told by the people at the office that he was "good to go", which led him to believe that he was fine to operate. We instructed him that he should contact those responsible, who issue the licences and find out if he could get a copy of the license or if he needed to have his license appear in front of committee or the common council.

We informed ALKHATIB that we would be following up with him in few days, to see if the city would issue him his licenses so he could operate or if he would have to remain closed until the committee and the common council approved his licenses.

We will be following up in the next few days regarding the business licenses.

My name is _____ and I am addressing you in regards to the new Lounge 340 located at 340 E Reservoir Ave. in your district.

My Fiancé and I bought our first home at _____ at the end of November _____. My property is located _____, the intersection from the newly established Lounge 340. My fiancé and I both work in the _____ and we chose the house we did because it was located in a quite neighborhood but still very close to all the amenities downtown has to offer without the noise from downtown.

Since the opening of Lounge 340 my life has been effected daily. The staff and owners of the property reached out with a letter to introduce the business to the neighborhood stating that their opening day would be Saturday March 2nd.

Thursday February 28th at 9:45 pm after trying to contact the owners about their noise level, I contacted the MPD and talked with Officer MacRae who handled the situation. Since then, the owners and I have built a relationship that I respect, and I sincerely believe they are trying to run a great business and respect the neighborhood they are in.

Since opening, I have personally contacted Kamesha about noise 4 times and she has either turned down the music or said it was somebody parked outside the bar with loud music playing in their car.

This is where my problem begins, The property has no parking lot. So

the patrons of Lounge 340 park outside my house before, during, and after business hours. The once quiet neighborhood has now turned into cars with loud music, people hanging out outside the bar being loud, and most importantly leaving the bar and sitting outside their car talking/yelling/ arguing at all hours of the night. On multiple occasions I have witnessed patrons smoking marijuana in their cars right outside my residence and I have also noticed more alcohol related litter around my residence. So far only once I have had to go outside and tell 3 intoxicated women to please be quiet and go home, which was at 2:45am on a Wednesday night.

I have been in contact with Officer MacRae on how to do my part as a homeowner in your district and here I am contacting you. Officer MacRae told me that vehicles parked out front of my residence are out of the scope of the bars control. I could understand this situation if I lived downtown but not in a residential neighborhood.

Alderman Coggs, My fiancé and I work at early hours in the morning. We are and have worked very hard to afford the home we have. I will continue to have a respectful relationship with Lounge 340 as long as they continue to respect the neighborhood. I ask that you review my thoughts and concerns and take into consideration the location of this establishment when reissuing a license. This quite residential neighborhood is not a place for a bar, especially a bar that doesn't offer a parking lot to control its patrons in a quite residential neighborhood.



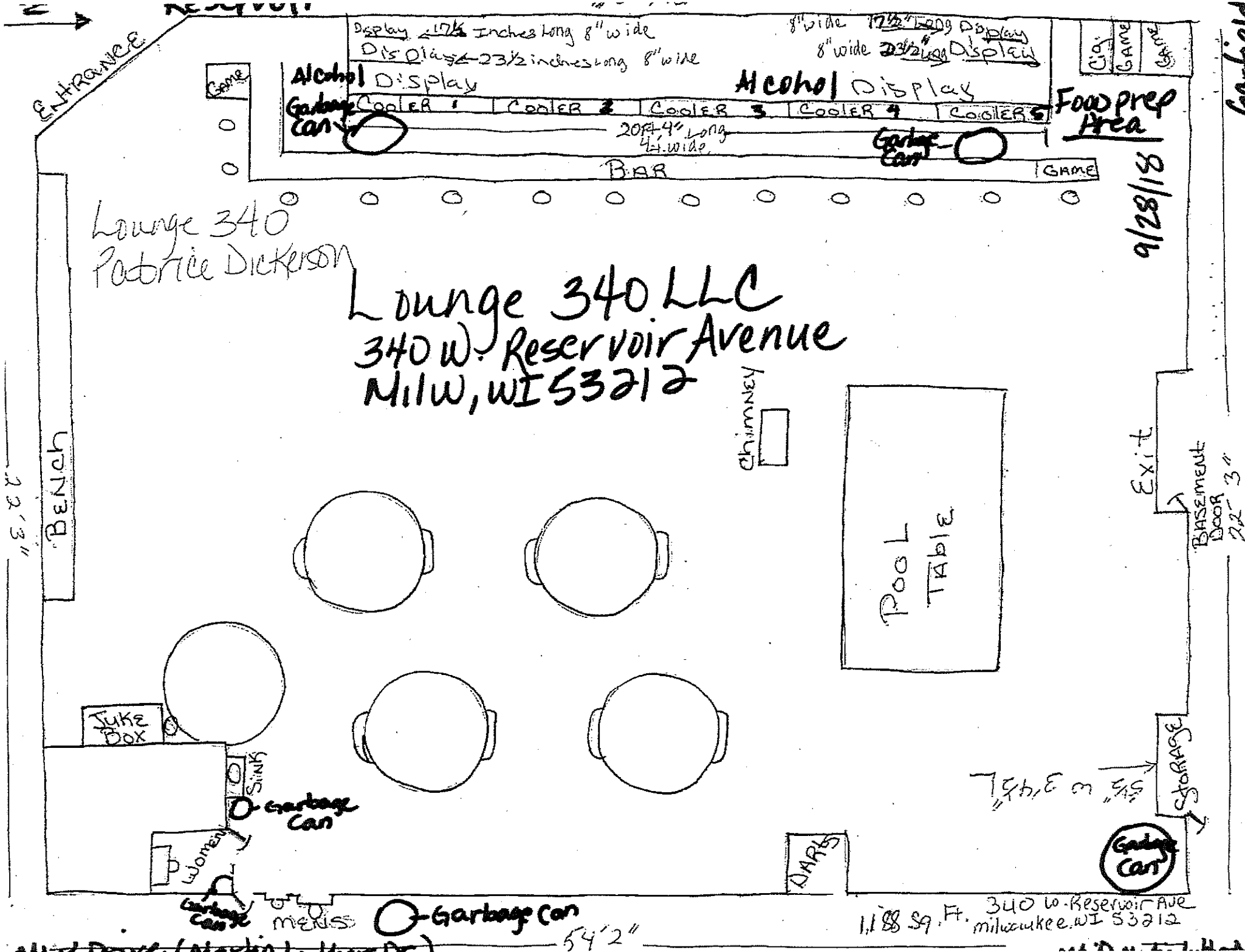



On 12-05-18 at 1:15 a.m. PO Russell MACRAE and I conducted follow up at the Day's Inn Mai Bar, located at 1840 N. 6th St., which is a licensed premise in the city of Milwaukee. We were attempting to conduct follow up regarding a check that I conducted on 11-30-18, in which the bartender Ebony LEE (b/f 09-13-91) did not have a Class D Bartenders license on her person.

While at the location, we spoke to Andrew B. SALUD (w/m 10-02-90), who was bartending. I asked SALUD if he had his Class D Bartenders license on his person and he stated he did not, that he was the step son of the agent, Kevin D. PERKINS. I asked SALUD for his identification and he provided his information. I asked him if his address on his license was current, 6650 N. 91st St., which is the listed address for PERKINS. SALUD was asked if he was still living at this address and he stated he "kinda" lives there, but is staying on N. Martin Luther King Jr. Dr., as it is closer to work. He continued to tell us that he stays there a few days a week with a roommate, but still has items at the 91st St. address and that he does stay there from time to time.

SALUD stated he did not have a Class D Bartenders license. He then contacted his mother, who owns the bar, but is not the licensed agent for the bar. I informed SALUD that I would be contacting PERKINS regarding this incident, as well as the incident from 11-30-18. SALUD stated that if he needed a license, that he would voluntarily close the bar tonight, which he did. We informed him that if he is going to live somewhere else and not have permanent residence with PERKINS, that it would be in his best interest to apply and get a Class D Bartenders license.

I checked the LIRA system for LEE, if she has a Class D Bartenders license, but could not locate a bartender's license. I also checked LIRA for SALUD, but could not locate one for him either. Based on the statements from SALUD, we will also be issuing him a citation for not having a Class D Bartenders license. I will also be issuing LEE a citation as well in regards to report # 18-334-0151.
