- > 1. Electric load: Data centers can use as much power as 50,000+ homes. With rates already rising, this risks higher costs for residents and strain on the grid.
- > 2. Water use: Many facilities use millions of gallons/day for cooling. In a Great Lakes city, stewardship matters — that's ratepayer water and thermal discharge into our lake/river systems.

- > I urge you to require a full environmental impact study, public hearings on utility agreements, and transparency on tax incentives before any approvals.
