5. On 06/24/13, at 12:45 am, Milwaukee police were dispatched to 1135 N Water Street for a Fight complaint. Police spoke with the bar manager, David Kuklin, who stated there were a group of females in the front area of the bar who were verbally arguing with each other for an unknown reason, when the fight became physical. Kuklin stated his security broke up the fight and escorted the females out of the bar. All parties fled prior to police arrival.

6. On 12/15/2013 Milwaukee police responded to a fight complaint at 1135 North Water Street (McGillcuddy's Tavern). Investigation revealed that a fight took place inside the business and an individual who works as security was struck in the back of the head with a glass during the fight. The victim received 6 staples in the back of the head as a result of this incident. Milwaukee police incident report #133500003 filed.

7. On 02/02/2014 Milwaukee police responded to a fight complaint at 1135 North Water Street (McGilluddy's Tavern). Investigation revealed two patrons of the business were involved in an altercation. Both patrons were cited.

8. On 05/03/2014 a 20 year old Milwaukee police aide, working in conjunction with Milwaukee police, attempted to gain entry to McGillycuddy's Tavern (133-1137 North Water Street). The police aide was turned away when she could not provide proof she had turned 21 years of age.

9. On 10/27/2014 Milwaukee police responded to a battery complaint at 740 West Wisconsin Avenue #103. The victim, James Newkirk, told officers he had been at McGillycuddy's Bar (1135 North Water Street) the previous evening (10/26/2015) and someone punched him in the face. Mr. Newkirk stated he was intoxicated and has absolutely no recollection of what happened. He further stated the manager of the bar gave him a ride to St. Mary's hospital where he was diagnosed with a concussion, a fractured right eye socket, and two broken teeth. Officers spoke to the general manager of the business, Tate Winckler, who stated he was aware of a fight the previous night because the manager told him about it. Mr. Winckler also told officers there are no working cameras inside the bar, that the manager was currently unavailable for interview and that no one from the business had called police. Milwaukee police incident report # 143000136 filed.

10. On 11/01/2014 Matthew Sokol walked into Milwaukee police district #1 to report that his wallet had been stolen from his rear pocket the previous evening while at McGillicuddy's (1135 North Water Street). Mr. Sokol also told officers he had no idea who took it. Milwaukee police incident report #143050071 filed.
11. On 01/18/2015 Milwaukee police responded to a battery complaint at 1135 North Water Street (McGillicuddy's). The victim stated he was escorting an unruly patron from the business when he was punched in the face by another patron. Both patrons were apprehended and cited.
12. On 02/19/2015 Milwaukee police conducted a licensed premise check at 1133 North Water Street (McGillicuddy's) and provided Patrick Murthey was a packet of tavern related ordinances.
13. On 02/27/2015 a 19 year old Milwaukee police aide, working in conjunction with Milwaukee police, attempted to gain entry to McGillicuddy's (1133 North Water Street) but was denied when she could not produce proof she had attained the legal drinking age of 21.
14. On 08/08/2015 a 20 year old Milwaukee police aide, working in conjunction with Milwaukee police, attempted to gain entry to McGillicuddy's (1133 North Water Street) but was denied when she could not produce proof she had attained the legal drinking age of 21.

15. On 10/23/2015 Milwaukee police, while inside McGillicuddy's Tavern (1135 North Water Street) on a Code Red Deployment, were advised by a security guard that he had been stabbed. Investigation revealed two patrons of the business had been told to leave by security. One of the patrons dropped his right hand and thrust it back up, striking the security guard in the left side of his stomach. The security guard saw blood and realized he had a laceration to his abdomen. This laceration required 3 sutures. This same patron punched another security guard in the eye. Milwaukee police incident report #152970015 filed.
16. On 01/17/2016 Milwaukee police were flagged down by the manager at McGillicuddys tavern (1135 North Water Street) who stated there was a fight involving as many as 15 people at the business. Officers observed numerous subjects involved in a fight and cited 4 individuals for disorderly conduct.
17. On 02/04/2016 Milwaukee police conducted a training course at The Winchester (2321 North Murray Avenue) regarding the use and identification of fake driver licenses and other identification for gaining entry into taverns. A representative of McGillicuddy's Bar and Grill was present at this training.

18. On 10/15/2016 at 2:35am officers arrested subjects in front of McGillicuddy's tavern, 1135 N. Water St. The subjects were not related to the tavern but the manager assisted the officers with retrieval of video surveillance which aided the investigation.
19. On 03/30/2017 officers conducted underage tavern enforcement in District 1. An underage Police Aid attempted to gain entry to McGillicuddy's, at 1133 N. water St. The Police Aid was denied by security at the door.

20. On 06/25/2017 officers observed two subjects being pushed out the front door at McGillycuddy's, 1135 N. water St. The subjects began fighting and it took several officers to stop the fight and arrest the subjects. A review of video surveillance inside showed the same two subjects fighting inside then being pushed outside.

21. On 07/23/2017 a subject walked in to District one to file a complaint of a battery that occurred at McGillycuddy's. 1135 N. Water St. The victim stated he was at McGillycuddy's with a female friend when a subject grabbed her arm. He stepped toward the subject and asked him why he grabbed her arm. The subject then punched him in the face. The bar separated the parties, sending one set to the front and one to the back. The manager stated he thought it was an argument and didn't realize anyone was hurt until after the parties left. The victim was treated at St Mary's hospital and the lacerations required 13 stitches to close. MPD report filed.

22. On 01/27/2018 officers were dispatched to McGillycuddy's, 1135 N. Water St., for a fight between three females. When the officer arrived the manager pointed out three females that were walking away. The subjects stated they were kicked out of the bar for no reason and one of the staff called one of the subjects a racial name. Since the subjects were not fighting each other they were allowed to leave. Later the officer learned that a staff member was hit with a thrown bottle while kicking out the subjects. The employee required 6 stitched to close a cut above his eye. There was no video that captured this incident.

23. On 03/05/2018 officers were dispatched to 1135 N. Water St for a battery complaint. The officers spoke with the complainant who was security guard at the establishment. He stated as he was kicking out a subject who jumped the fence the subject hit him with a closed fist. The subject was arrested and conveyed to the District.

24. On 03/31/2018 officers investigated a battery complaint at McGillyCuddy's Bar, 1135 N. Water St. The victim stated he was hit by another patron while he was inside the bar. The officers observed the video tape, which did capture the incident.

25. On 04/22/2018 officers were dispatched to a fight at 1135 N. Water St. The staff stated there was a subject, who threatened to shoot up the premise, inside refusing to leave. The officers spoke with the subject and were able to get him to leave. The staff stated they did not want to file a complaint and just wanted the subject to leave.

26. On 11/24/2018 officers investigated a battery at St Joseph's hospital, that occurred at McGillycuddy's bar, 1135 N. Water St. The victim stated he was in the patio area and was struck by a flying bottle which caused a laceration to his face. He stated he did not tell any staff members or police in the area and just went home. The victim stated he did not want a police report. The officer spoke with the manager at McGillycuddy's, who stated he was aware the police came in the night before but did not know about any incidents that night. He allowed officers to view the surveillance video, which did not show the incident.

27. On 11/29/2018 officers conducted underage tavern enforcement in District 1. An underage Police Aide attempted to gain entry to McGillycuddy's, 1135 N. Water St. The Police Aide was allowed entry and was served a Miller Lite at the bar. The bartender was identified and issued a citation.

28. On 03/31/2019 at 2:07am officers were flagged down for a fight at McGillicuddy's, 1135 N. Water St. The officers spoke with several people who stated they were punched by security while being escorted out after a fight. The officers viewed the video surveillance which did show the fight. They observed security break up the fight and escorting the subjects out but did not observe any security officer punch a patron. The staff was cooperative with the officers and handled the incident appropriately.

29. On 07/21/2019 at 2:00am officers were flagged down by security at McGillicuddy's, 1135 N. Water St, for a Trouble with Subject. Security pointed out a subject who attempted to punch them. The subject fled when the officers attempted to stop him. He was caught and issued citations.

30. On 08/14/2019 at 2:12am officers observed 5 people walk out of McGillicuddy's, 1135 N. Water St, after closing time. The officers entered and observed an additional patron exit the bathroom. The manager stated he thought it was okay to have patrons in after hours as long as they were not drinking. The manager was advised to have all patrons out of the building by closing time.

~~31. On 08/30/2019 at 11:51pm officers were flagged down by McGillicuddy's, 1135 N. Water St, for a Trouble with Subject. The officers observed security detaining subject. The investigation revealed the subject attempted to leave without paying for his bar tab. He was issued a citation and released from the district.~~

32. On 10/06/2019 at 10:38pm officers were dispatched to a fight at McGillicuddy's bar, 1135 N. Water St. The caller reported 20 people fighting both inside and outside the bar. When the officer arrived they observed a large fight that required 7 squad to be caller to restore order. The security cameras did capture the fight.

33. On 10/14/2019 at 9:45pm officers were flagged down for a Trouble with Subject complaint outside of McGillicuddy's bar, 1135 N. Water St. The security guard stated a subject was intoxicated and was kicked out for attempting to fight other patrons. The subject was locked out and damaged the door attempting to get back inside. The subject was cited for Disorderly Conduct and Damage to Property.

34. On 12/10/2019 officers conducted fake ID training for McGillicuddy's staff. About 15 employees were in attendance and learned how to prevent underage drinking.

35. On 03/20/21 at 2:18am, Milwaukee Police responded to a battery/cutting which occurred on the sidewalk in front of 1135 N. Water Street. Investigation revealed that a verbal altercation began outside the tavern and a subject stabbed another subject in the stomach three times requiring medical attention. During the incident, the tavern was empty of patrons and the owner of the establishment was cooperative with officers providing them with video surveillance which ultimately led to the subject's arrest. There were no tavern violations observed.

36. On 04/01/21 at 10:41pm, Milwaukee Police conducted a license premise check at 1135 N. Water Street. No violations were observed, the establishment was cooperative and appeared to be following all Covid guidelines.

37. On 09/04/21 at 2:13am, Milwaukee Police, while on foot patrol, observed a fight spill outside the vestibule of 1135 N. Water Street. Officers intervened in the altercation and investigation revealed that several subjects inside the tavern were harassing a couple of female patrons and a fight ensued between patrons. Security broke up the fight and had to physically escort them out of the establishment. Security acted with restraint while ejecting these patrons and were helpful with the police on scene dealing with the fight outside.

38. On 05/30/22, Milwaukee Police, while on foot patrol in the N. Water Street tavern area, were flagged down by citizens and told that there were subjects with guns on the patio at 1135 N. Water Street. While standing outside the patio area, officers observed citizen's dragging a subject out of the patio and onto the sidewalk. The group then walked away and out of eyesight of the officers. Officers then heard a gunshot and while investigating, began a foot chase with the subject described by the citizen as having the gun. The subject was apprehended and charged.

39. On 07/14/22 at 12:52am, Milwaukee Police, while monitoring the tavern district around N. Water Street and E. Juneau Avenue, observed a large fight outside 1135 M. Water Street. Investigation revealed that the fight started between two groups inside the establishment and continued outside after security escorted out. Employees were cooperative with the investigation.

40. On 10/07/22 at 8:05p.m., Milwaukee Police conducted a License Premise Check at 1135 N. Water St. This was the second time officers have spoken to the manager regarding wands, and the establishment seemed resistant to implement their use, despite this being a safety measure for both employees and customers. The suggestion came from officers after arresting two patrons at the bar in the summer, both armed with a firearm. The manager on duty stated the wands should be available by the end of the month.

41. On 10/15/22 at 12:25a.m., Milwaukee Police were investigating a fight at 1135 N. Water St. The employees were cooperative with the investigation and allowed officers to view video surveillance of the incident. Investigation revealed a fight broke out inside the establishment, the staff intervened and escorted two of the patrons out. The patrons walked up the street and a subject from the fight ran up and punched the patron in the face, causing their tongue to get stuck in the bracket of their braces.

42. On 10/16/22 at 8:09p.m., Milwaukee Police conducted follow-up at 1135 N. Water St., in regards to a Sexual Assault Complaint. The victim stated they were able to gain entrance to the establishment via a fake identification. The victim further stated while inside the restroom on the second floor, another patron entered the restroom, put their hands down the victim's pants and groped them. The manager was cooperative with the officers and took them to view video of the incident. The manager further stated they utilize a software system to check identification of patrons, that also take a picture of their ID card, and therefore they would be able to provide officers with that information as well.

43. On 01/01/23 at 12:08a.m., Milwaukee Police were flagged down at 1135 N. Water St., for a Sick and Injured. The officer spoke to a security guard who stated they were standing at the main entrance when they heard a loud thud come from the emergency exit. The security guard opened the door and observed a subject at the bottom of the stairs unconscious and bleeding from a laceration on their eyebrow. The subject was conveyed to a local hospital. There were no security cameras in the stairway.
44. On 02/26/23 at 8:17p.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Fight at 1135 N. Water St. Investigation revealed a verbal altercation took place between two patrons, when one of the patrons struck the other in the head with a can of White Claw, causing a small laceration. The employees were cooperative and allowed officers to view video surveillance of the incident.
45. On 03/03/23 at 12:54a.m., Milwaukee Police were monitoring Water St., when they were asked to investigate a fight that occurred at 1135 N. Water St. The manager advised the officers they were escorting a subject outside for verbally arguing with another patron, when the subject tried to grab the other patron, and a physical fight broke out. The manager stated at that time they observed officers outside and flagged them down to assist in breaking up the fight.

46. On 03/04/23 at 12:27a.m., Milwaukee Police were flagged down for a theft at 1135 N. Water. The officer was advised by a security guard that their watch was stolen during an attempt to break up a physical fight between patrons in Item #44.
47. On 04/28/23 at 11:05p.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Tavern Violation at 1135 N. Water St. A Milwaukee Police Sergeant observed a patron attempting to jump over a fence in order to gain entry to the establishment, with two patrons inside the fence attempting to assist. This behavior caused the Sergeant to conduct a Tavern Check, which they observed at least 40-50 people they believed to be underage. An announcement was made for any patrons that were underage to leave immediately. Upon the announcement patrons began to leave the establishment. Due to the number of patrons leaving and limited officers to assist, they were unable to issue any citations. The manager on scene was cooperative.
48. On 10/12/23 Milwaukee Police were conducting Underage Compliance Checks. At 9:15p.m, A Milwaukee Police Officer and an underage Police Aide attempted to gain entry to McGillicuddy's located at 1135 N. Water St. The Policer Officer provided Identification and the Police Aide did not and they were both denied entry by the bouncers. The manager was notified of the positive outcome of the check.

INITIAL INVESTIGATION

This report is written by P.O. Richard MICHALAK, assigned to District One, Late Power. On Friday October 7th, 2022 at approximately 8:05 P.M., P.O. Zavadil and I (sqd 1420) conducted a tavern check at McGillycuddy's Bar & Grill located at 1135 N. Water St.

On arrival, P.O. ZAVADIL spoke with the manager on duty Aaron Olson (w/m, 8-20-86). P.O. ZAVADIL stated to OLSON the reason for our check was to see if they have implemented wands for when customers come into their establishment. OLSON stated that "we should have them by the end of the month".

This is the second time P.O. ZAVADIL and I have spoken to OLSON regarding "wands". Both times OLSON has stated that they are waiting for upper management to make the decision and get them implemented. I also spoke with one of the owners of McGillycuddy's on a separate occasion and he seemed reluctant to use wands when customers walk in. They are hesitant because they feel it gives the bar a bad look and people will be less likely to come to their establishment. I mentioned to both they have nothing in place to keep customers and employees that are inside safe. It should be noted that in the summer Milwaukee Police Department did arrest two males that were inside McGillycuddy's and both subjects had firearms on them. I stated to both wanding and checking female pursues is a good start for the safety of their customers and employees. NONE of our suggestions have been implemented.

This report i written by PO Benjamin DELANEY, District 1, assigned to Late Power shift as Squad 1440 with Po Shawn SWITZER.

On Saturday October 15th 2022, at approximately 12:25 a.m. there was an altercation inside 1135 N Water St, McGillyCuddy's Bar & Grill. The altercation involved Aivars Jerins J. SEIVERT (w/m 12/07/96), his friend Brandon T DRIESSEN (w/m 08/27/97) getting into a fight with six other unknown males.

While investigating this incident the manager at McGillyCuddy's, Thomas J. TOMES (w/m 12/26/81) was cooperative and assisted by showing us the security footage from inside the bar. TOMES also stated that from what he could tell of the incident the six unknown males were the instigators and appeared to be trying to start a fight.

The footage of the incident showed the following: All the parties involved were on the second floor of the bar. The subjects appeared to be in a verbal argument. One of the six unknown male subjects shoves SEIVERT at which point SEIVERT retaliates by punching him. At this point a fight ensues between all the parties involved and the staff of McGillyCuddy's intervenes, breaks up the fight and escorts SEIVERT and DRIESSEN from the bar. Exterior footage shows SEIVERT and DRIESSEN leave the bar and walk northbound, turn west onto E Juneau Av and are then out of view of the cameras. According to DRIESSEN while out of view of the cameras one member of the six unknown males approaches SEIVERT from behind and punches him in the right side of his jaw/mouth area and the group of six males runs off.

SEIVERT was injured by the incident outside of the bar, getting his tongue stuck in the prongs of his braces. SEIVERT refused medical treatment on scene and did not wish to file a police report regarding this incident. Severity of SEIVERT's injury is unknown at this time.

Through the course of this investigation the staff of McGillyCuddy's was cooperative.
