You are hereby notified that the Milwaukee Common Council will hold a hearing on Wednesday, April 2, 2025, commencing at 9:00 a.m., or as soon thereafter as this matter may be heard, in the Common Council chambers on the third floor of City Hall, 200 East Wells Street, Milwaukee, Wisconsin to consider the renewal with a 15 (fifteen) day suspension of the Food Dealer and Weights & Measures licenses for the premises located at 3555 S Howell Av. ("Dollar Tree # 4823").

Attached you will find a copy of the Report of the Licenses Committee, which includes its Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, and Recommendation, recommending the renewal with a 15 (fifteen) day suspension of the Food Dealer and Weights & Measures licenses based upon the preponderance of the neighborhood, aldermanic and applicant testimony that demonstrates the operation results in a threat to the health, safety or welfare of the public for failure to comply with the approved plan of operations. This recommendation is the result of a public hearing before the Committee held on Thursday, March 6, 2025.
