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File # 050738 is a substitute resolution authorizing the Department of Employe Relations to contract with Willis of Wisconsin to complete a Medicare Part D Subsidy application.

Background

This resolution authorizes the Department of Employe Relations to contract with Willis of Wisconsin to complete a Medicare Part D subsidy application.

Discussion

- 1. The Medicare Modernization Act of 2003 was created by the United States Congress and provided for Medicare Part D including a prescription drug benefit that will be available to Medicare participants effective in 2006.
- 2. A Retiree Drug Subsidy of up to 28% is available from the United States Centers for Medicare and Medicaid to employers who provide a prescription drug benefit equivalent to the Medicare Part D plan.
- 3. An application process, including an actuarial determination, is required in order to verify that the City of Milwaukee's prescription drug benefit is equivalent to Medicare Part D.
- 4. Willis of Wisconsin, as a health care benefits consultant to the City of Milwaukee is in a position to complete this application process and the required actuarial determination of the City's eligibility for the drug subsidy.

Fiscal Effect

The total amount of this resolution is, up to, \$5,000 from the 2005 Health Care SPA, Cost Control sub-account for the purpose of conducting this application process.

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
