REASON FOR REQUEST:

Joseph Zawikowski, a City of Milwaukee police officer, was in the scope of his employment on bicycle patrol and conducting a traffic stop at approximately 2301 North 40th Street. During the traffic stop, the uninsured motorist disobeyed a lawful order and started to slowly drive away from the scene. The claimant then reached into the vehicle in an attempt to prevent the uninsured motorist from fleeing when the uninsured motorist accelerated knocking the claimant to the ground. As a result of the conduct of the uninsured motorist, there is liability on the City of Milwaukee pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 62.67 and the City of Milwaukee's Uninsured Motorist Self-Insurance Plan.

Officer Zawikowski sustained injuries to his left forearm and left shoulder. The treating physician indicated that the left shoulder injury is permanent. The claimed medical expenses and lost wages total \$124,988.33.
