A young man had jumped over my fence while being chase by several Milwaukee Police officers who also entered the yard by jumping over the fence and exiting out off the rear side. During the time of this incident both front and back gates were damaged causing them to be knocked of track, which has to be replaced (pictures enclosed). you will also see that some of my landscape lights were damaged during this chase by M.P.D. to apprehend the suspect. These fixtures were purchased at Home depot 11071 W National Av West Allis, WI. A total of eights lights were damaged two lights in a box for the price of \$16.97. I Sheila Milton would like some justice for the damages done to my property. Also enclosed are estimates of damages to both front and rear fence.

### INFORMATION AND RESOURCES FOR CRIME VICTIMS

Crime victims, and in some instances family members, are granted the following rights by state law:

- To receive protection from the offender throughout the criminal justice process.
- Assistance with an employer to minimize your loss of pay resulting from your cooperation with the criminal justice system.
- The prompt return of property when it is no longer needed by law enforcement as evidence.
- Information regarding financial restitution, compensation and other services.
- A speedy disposition of the criminal case.
- Be notified of court proceedings and hearings.
- To be accompanied to court by a service provider, have a separate waiting area and receive a witness fee for appearances in court.
- Communication with the District Attorney, criminal or juvenile court judge, victim or defendant's counsel, or juvenile court regarding the possible outcomes of the case.
- Provide a statement to the court at the time of disposition of the case, or parole of the offender, detailing the economic, psychological and physical impact of the crime.
- Be notified of parole hearings and release of the offender.
- In some cases, to request HIV testing of the offender and disclosure of results.

### CRIME VICTIM COMPENSATION

The Crime Victim Compensation Program may be available to help you pay for out-of-pocket expenses not covered by any insurance (such as medical bills and lost wages) which directly result from the crime even if there is no arrest or conviction. It is not available for property damage or loss. For information and applications contact:

If a **JUVENILE** is arrested, but not taken to the Detention Center, the police will be forwarding the reports to the Juvenile Intake Unit. Please note that these reports will be forwarded within two weeks. If you wish to exercise your rights to communicate with the Intake Worker please contact: Milwaukee County Children's Court Center, 10201 W. Watertown Plank Rd, Wauwatosa, WI 53226 (414) 257-7834.

Agencies in the criminal justice system will make a good faith attempt to contact you, and assist you in exercising your rights as a crime victim throughout the justice process. However, if you have questions or concerns please use the resources contained on this sheet to seek information in a timely fashion or call the contact officer above for assistance. Please notify the contact officer of any changes in your address or telephone number.
