There is a possibility that your application may be denied for one or more of the following reasons: The recommendation of the committee regarding the application shall be based on evidence presented at the hearing. Per MCO 85-4-4, unless otherwise specified in the code, probative evidence concerning non-renewal, suspension or revocation may include evidence of the following: failure of the applicant to meet municipal qualifications, pending charges against or the conviction of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the circumstances of the particular licensed or permitted activity, by the applicant or by any employee or other agent of the applicant. If the activities of the applicant involve a licensed premises, whether the premises tends to facilitate a public or private nuisance or has been the source of congregations of persons which have resulted in any of the following: disturbance of the peace; illegal drug activity; public drunkenness; drinking in public; harassment of passers-by; gambling; prostitution; sale of stolen goods; public urination; theft; assaults; battery; acts of vandalism including graffiti, excessive littering, loitering, illegal parking, loud noise at times when the licensed premise is open for business; traffic violations; curfew violations; lewd conduct; display of materials harmful to minors, pursuant to s. 106-9.6; or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety and welfare, or failure to comply with the approved plan of operation. See attached police report or correspondence.

Notice for applicants with warrants or unpaid fines:

Proof of warrant satisfaction or payment of fines must be submitted at the hearing on the above date and time. Failure to comply with this requirement may result in a delay of the granting/denial of your application.

Failure to appear at this meeting may result in the denial of your license. Individual applicants must appear only in person or by an attorney. Corporate or Limited Liability applicants must appear only by the agent designated on the application or by an attorney. Partnership applicants must appear by a partner listed on the application or by an attorney. If you wish to do so and at your own expense, you may be accompanied by an attorney of your choosing to represent you at this hearing.

You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify. You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. If you have difficulty with the English language, you should bring an interpreter with you, at your expense, so that you can answer questions and participate in your hearing.

You may examine the application file at this office during regular business hours prior to the hearing date. Inquiries regarding this matter may be directed to the person whose signature appears below.

4. On 04/25/23 at 8:13pm, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 230 E. Capitol Drive for a threat compliant. Investigation revealed that a customer was making threats towards an employee because her order was wrong. The manager stated that both parties were arguing with each other and the customer was given a refund.

- 5. On 07/01/23 at 4:38pm, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 230 E. Capitol Drive for a battery compliant. Officers spoke with manager who stated that two of the store employee got in a physical altercation. One of the employees remained on scene while the other ran away from the location, and was terminated immediately. The employee on scene complained of pain to his shoulder. The employee stated that he got into a disagreement with the coworker and then got pushed against the wall, knocked down then punched in the face. The business was cooperative with the investigation and provided video. The video showed the incident in it's entirely. The employee was conveyed to the hospital for medical attention.
- 6. On 07/29/23 at 10:25pm, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 230 E. Capitol Drive for a subject with gun compliant. Investigation revealed that an employee dropped some change on the ground while giving it to a customer and the employee told the customer to pick it up off the ground. The customer observed that the employee had a handgun with an extended magazine but did not point it. The two shift managers on duty refused to cooperate with officers and give any information. The officers did not review security footage because of the uncooperative managers and did not enter the premise because the shift managers were uncooperative.

On Tuesday, April 25th, 2023, at 8:13 PM, My partner Sophia ALAMO and I were dispatched to a threat compliant at TACO BELL 230 E. Capitol Dr., located in the City and County of Milwaukee.

Upon arrival to the listed we spoke to the caller who identified herself as Tracy T. BOOTHE (b/f, 05-31-1978), 414-882-9091. BOOTHE reported the employees at TACO BELL got her order wrong and she was trying to have them fix her order or get a refund. BOOTHE stated she paid approximately \$50.25 for her meal. BOOTHE reported the employees and her began to argue over the situation and making threats towards her saying they would beat her up. BOOTHE stated this did not make her fear for her safety.

We spoke to Taco Bell employees who stated BOOTHE was the one was acting disorderly.

We were able to get BOOTHE her refund for TACO BELL meal.

BOOTHE was issued a community contact card.

I spoke to the Taco Bell Manager Patrice R. TILLMAN (b/f, 08-04-1987) about the incident, who stated both sides were arguing and nothing physical occurred.

While on scene TILLMAN was unable to locate the licenses for us to view. However, I did not observe any violations while on scene.

This report is written by Police Officer Evan BILLER, assigned to District 5 Early shift, squad 5220(PO Adrianna LAMACK).

On Saturday July 1, 2023, at approximately 4:38 p.m., my partner and I were dispatched to the address of 230 E Capitol Dr (Taco Bell) in the city and county of Milwaukee to investigate a Battery complaint.

Upon arrival we met with the manager/caller who verbally identified herself as Patrice R. TILLMAN (B/F, 08-04-87). TILLMAN stated that two of her employees got into a physical fight in the lobby. The two employees were identified as Ltriel D. BROWN (B/M, 10-08-04) and Randy R. DAVIS (B/M, 04-22-03). After talking with TILLMAN, BROWN was still on scene and had pain to his right shoulder. BROWN told us his side of the story which was that he and DAVIS were talking. BROWN then said DAVIS started to get loud with him for no reason, so they started to argue, it was at that time DAVIS pushed BROWN into a cement wall causing BROWN to hit his back. When BROWN was on the ground DAVIS started to punch him in the face, at this time TILLMAN seen this fight happening and broke it up. After the fight was broken up DAVIS fled the scene on foot in an unknown direction and was terminated from TACO BELL immediately.

The video on scene that officers viewed showed DAVIS and BROWN in the front lobby talking while the other employees were in the back by the grill. DAVIS and BROWN exchanged words and started to get in each other's face. When in each other's face DAVIS pushed BROWN causing him to hit his back on the cement wall that separates the dine in area from the order line. When BROWN was on the floor DAVIS punched him multiple times in the face before BROWN started to swing back. After several minutes of the employees fighting, TILLMAN notices them in the lobby and runs over to separate DAVIS AND BROWN. After TILLMAM is on the phone with police DAVIS runs out the side door that leads into the parking lot.

BROWN was transported by Bell 434 to St. Marys for medical treatment on her right should that was sore.

Staff that was on scene were cooperative in the investigation and assisted officers any way they could.

On Saturday, July 29th, 2023, at approximately 10:25 PM, I was dispatched to 230 E Capitol Dr., Taco Bell, for a Subject with Gun Complaint, along with my partner Police Officer Kalin WELCH.

## INTERVIEW OF CALLER:

Upon arrival, I spoke to the caller, who was identified as Channing A. WINTERS (M/B 10-13-1985). WINTERS stated he was getting food at Taco Bell. WINTERS stated one of the employees gave him his change back, however, dropped it on the ground and the drive-thru window. WINTERS stated the employee told him to "Pick up the change".

WINTERS stated he observed the employee to had an army-colored handgun with an extended

magazine. WINTERS stated the employee did not physically point the firearm at him. WINTER was able to provide video of the employee with the firearm, which officers reviewed.

End of interview.

There were to shift managers present at the time of this investigation, however, both refused to cooperate and provide any information.

The shift managers stated the incident arose due to a nickel in US currency. The shift managers stated the employee had ended their shift at approximately 10 PM and had left.

Officers did not review surveillance footage from the Taco Bell, as the shift managers were uncooperative.

Officers did not enter the premise, as the doors were locked and the shift managers were uncooperative. Officers did review an online licensee search for the premise and it was revealed that the premise was validly licensed.
