This is an ordinance relating to the change in zoning from General Planned Development (GPD) to Industrial Light (IL1), on land located on the North Side of West Calumet Road and West of North 76th Street, in the 9th Aldermanic District. This ordinance allows for the development of the site as a landscape contractor's office and yard, outdoor storage and landscape material sales. This zoning change was applied for by Rodger Northouse. 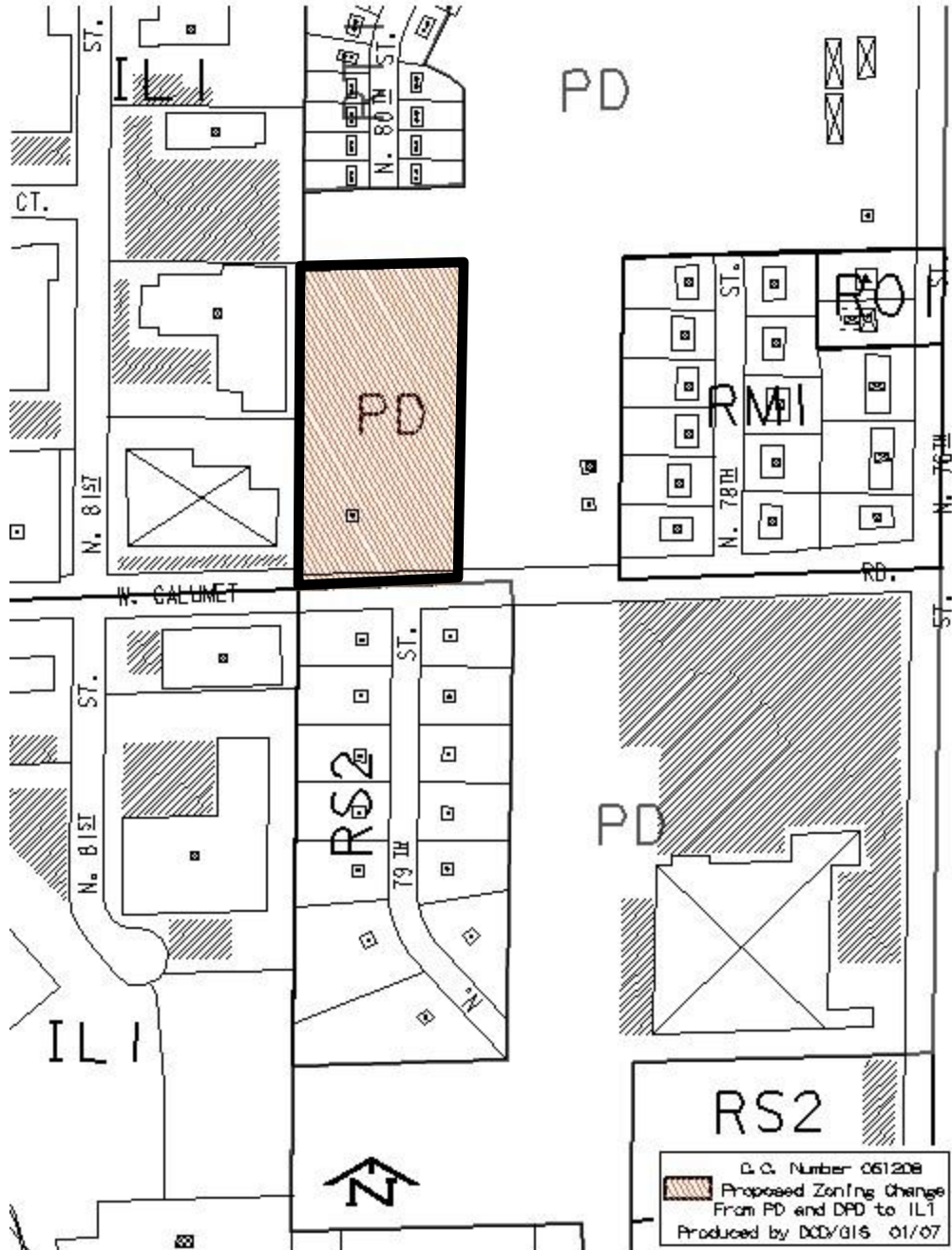
