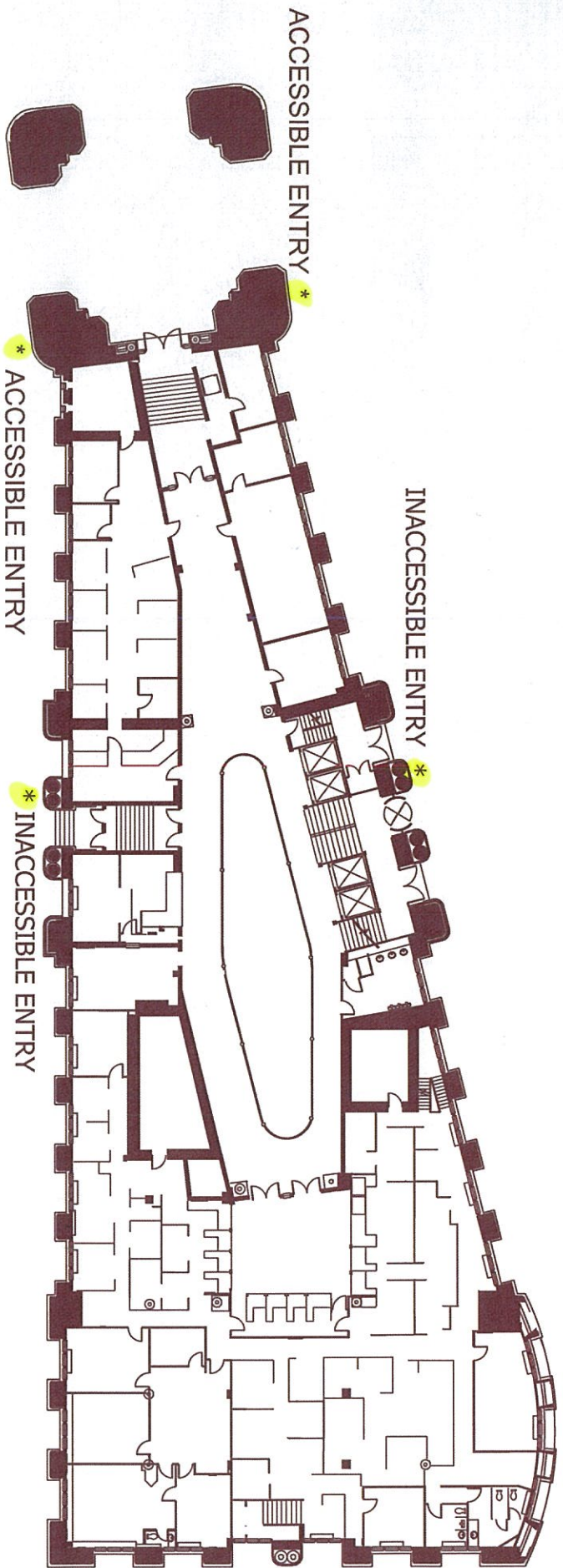

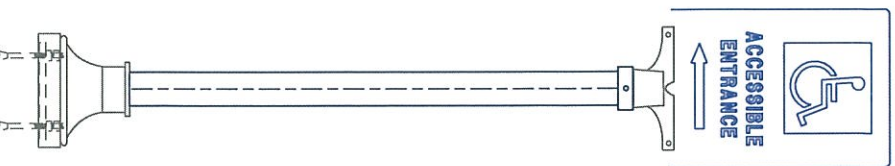

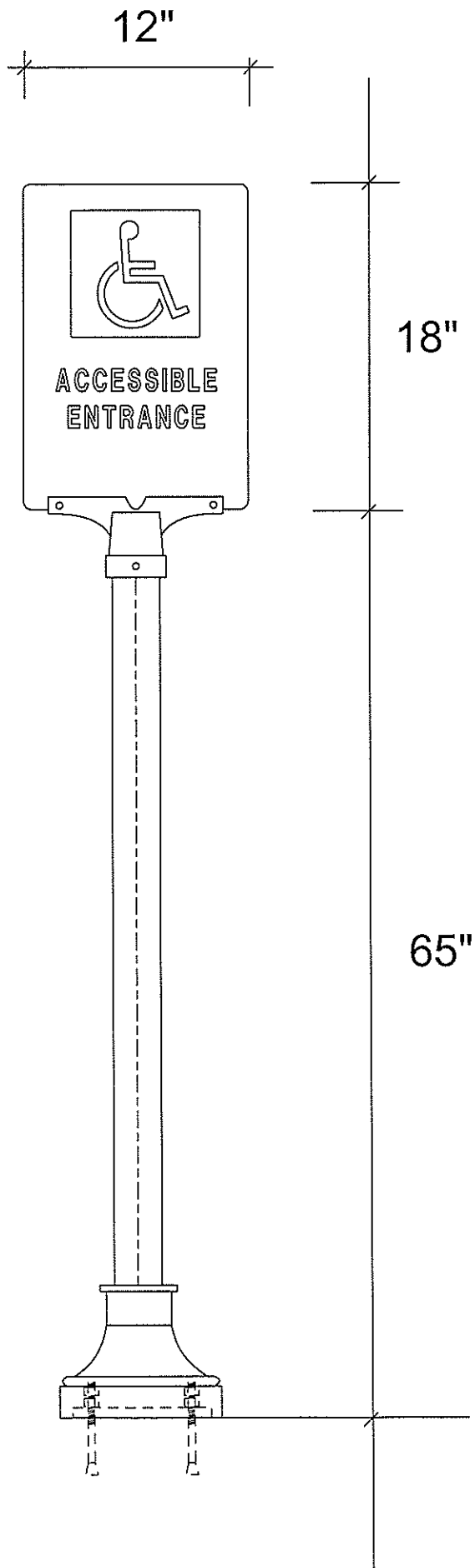

City Hall ADA Directional Sign Locations

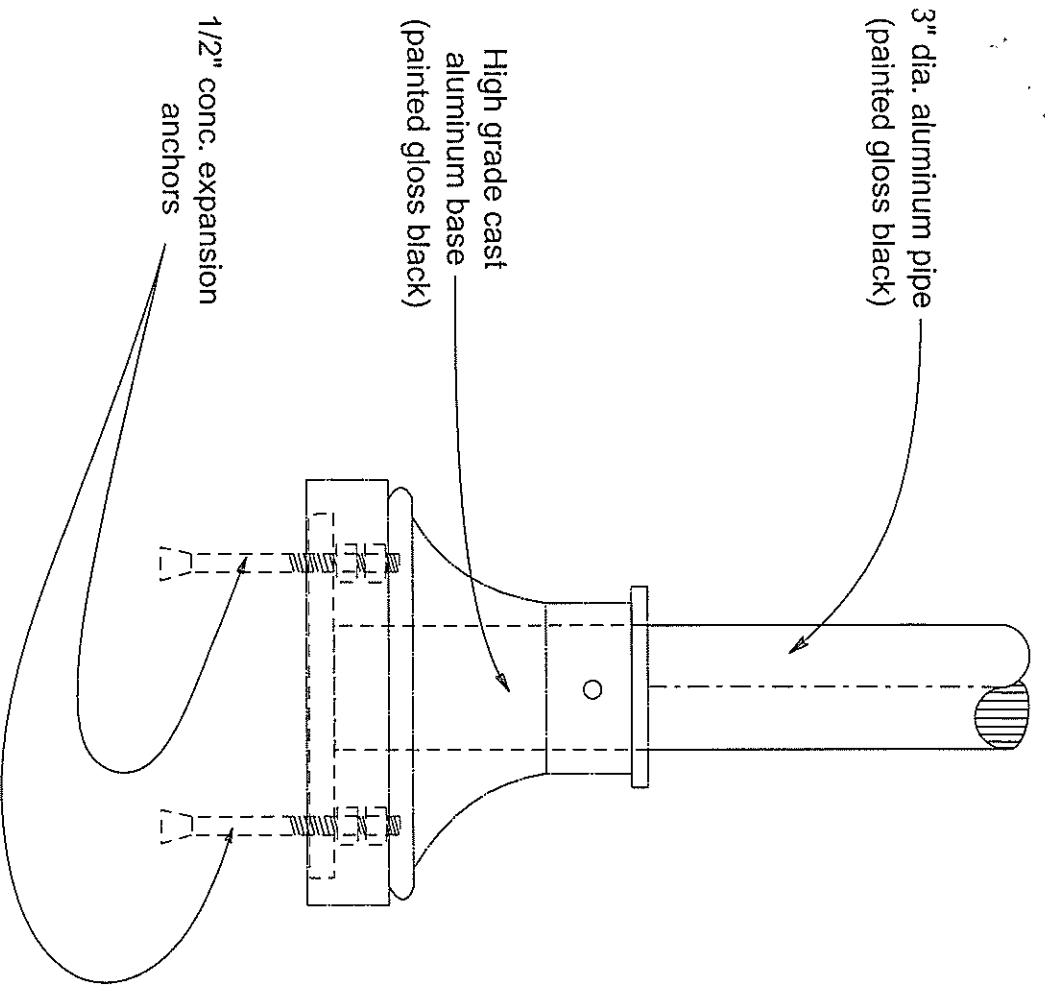


East Inaccessible Entry CITY HALL



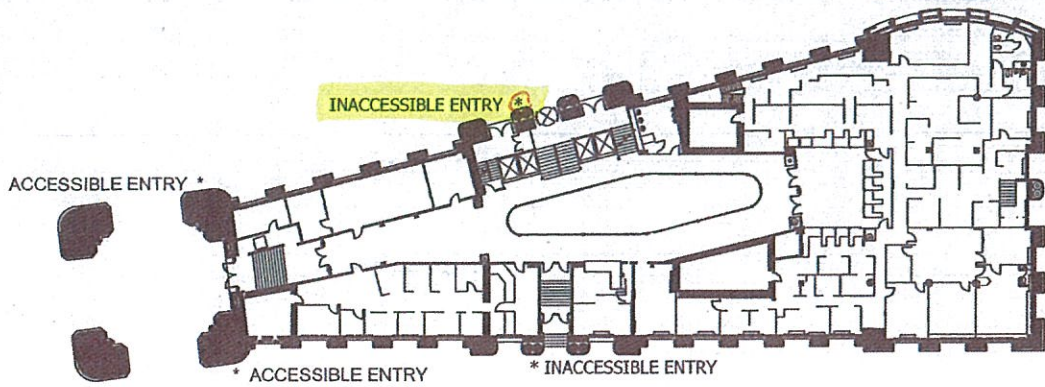
City Hall ADA Exterior Directional Signage



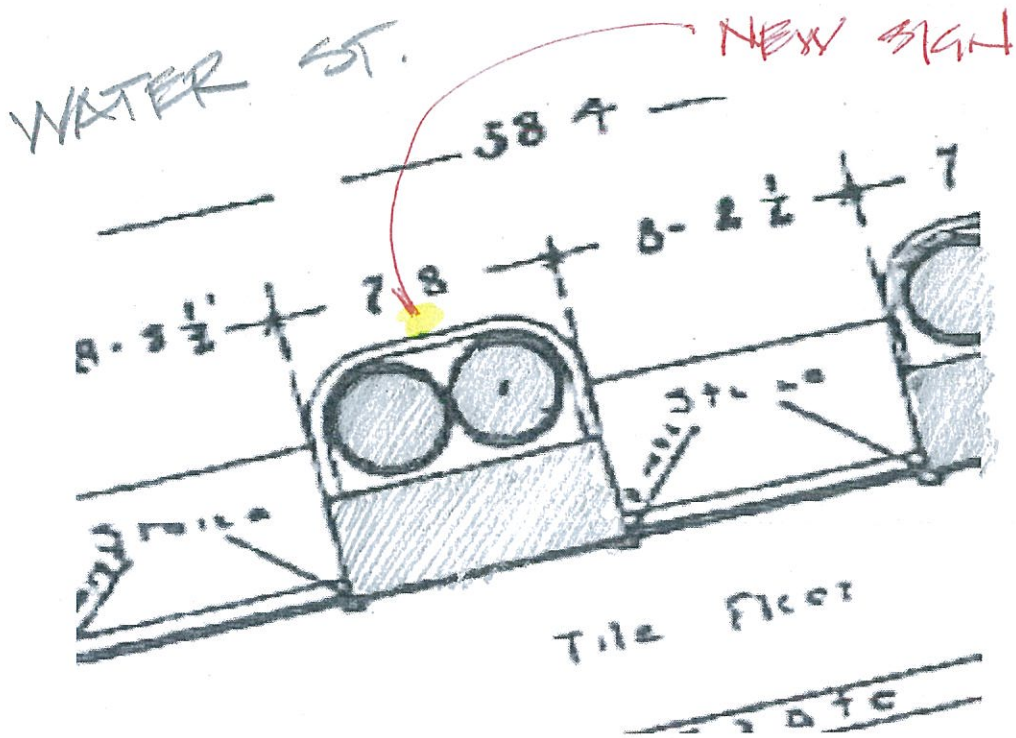


Sign Base Detail

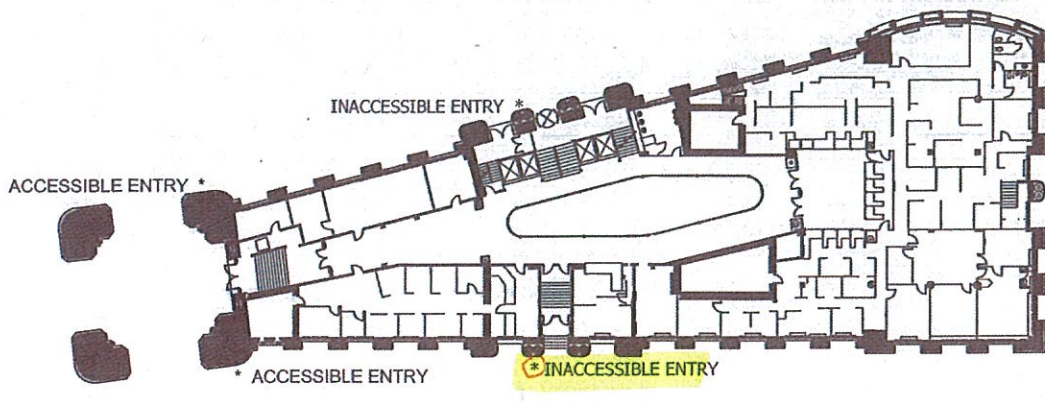

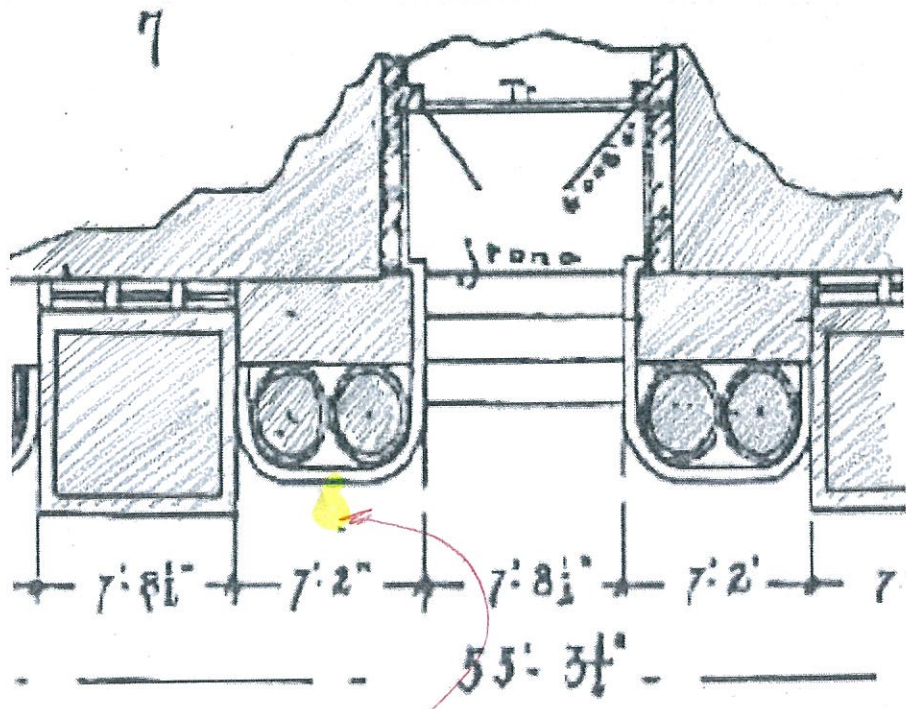
