To Whom It May Concern:

On July 15th, 2004 my family and I, <u>Latoun R. Valtchev</u>, left the United States of America to go to my homeland (Bulgaria, EUROPE) for a vacation. I returned to the United States of America in the evening of August 17th, 2004. Before I left for my vacation, I parked my vehicle at the visitor's parking zone. At that time, my family and I resided on the following address (Woodland Court Apartments):

3975 South 76th Street #6 Milwaukee, WI 53220

All of the events described below, regarding this matter, took place on the Woodland Court parking lot for the address given above. On August 2nd, 2004 a tolling sticker from the police department was placed on my car saying that I need to move my vehicle from the visitor's parking zone to my assigned parking spot (#58) within 3 days period of time. On August 3rd, 2004 around 5:30 p.m. – 6:00 p.m. my daughter, Kremena L. Valtcheva, moved my car to my assigned parking spot. On August 4th, 2004 my daughter, Kremena L. Valtcheva, called Matthew Gingras, a Leasing Consultant at Woodland Court, and notified him that she had moved the car. In addition, Kremena asked him to call the police department to let them know that the car is moved and that they do not need to toll it. On August 5th, 2004 around 5:30 a.m. my daughter saw that the car was missing from the assigned parking spot.

Before I went to vacation, the area that I had parked my car was a visitor's parking zone at the time. At some point, that visitor's parking zone turned into a no parking zone. We only became aware of that on August 3rd, 2004. An authorized person from Woodland Court apartments called the police saying that the car was abandoned. However, the car was not abandoned due to the fact that I was permanently residing at that particular address. The car should not have been tolled because it was moved within the three days period of time given by the police and when it was tolled, it was tolled from its assigned parking spot. The car was not located in the no parking zone at the time of the tolling; rather, it was parked in its assigned spot.

I am writing in regards to getting my money back. Due to wrongfully tolling my vehicle, I would like to receive the money I paid for the tolling (a total of \$195) back. I have attached a copy of the receipt for all the tolling charges which I would like to receive my money back for. My daughter, Kremena Valtcheva, went to the Milwaukee downtown municipal courthouse and talked to the district attorney. The district attorney suggested or told her to write a letter and sent it to this address to appeal to get our money back.
