You are invited to attend a hearing on Friday, March 6th, at 10:15 a.m., in room 301-B, Milwaukee City Hall at 200 E. Wells St. Your Class "B" Tavern and Tavern Dance licenses for the premises at 3040 W. Atkinson Ave. ("Jamaica Inn") may be revoked based upon sworn charges from the Milwaukee Police Department.

I have enclosed a copy of the charges filed by the Milwaukee Police Department, your license application, and a copy of the police report, which is all that is currently in the file. You will be given an opportunity to respond to and challenge the reasons for revocation, to present witnesses under oath and to confront and cross-examine witnesses under oath. You may also be represented by an attorney of your choice, at your expense. Your licenses may be revoked in the event that the objections are found to be true.
